## Ganesh Puja and its Cultural Significance

Ganesh Chaturthi, also known as Vinayaka Chaturthi, or Vinayaka Chaviti is a Hindu festival celebrating the arrival of Ganesh to earth from Kailash Parvat with his mother Goddess Parvati/ Gauri. The festival is marked with the installation of Ganesh clay idols privately in homes and publicly by Sri Bal Gangadhar Tilak popularly known as Lokmanya Tilak in Pune in the year 1893 on elaborate pandals (temporary stages).

It which falls in the vedic month of Bhadra (mid August-September). It is associated with Lord Ganpati or Ganesha- the most loved god who has 108 names. He is considered to be a bestower of good fortune, wisdom, knowledge, prosperity and wealth. Ganpati is also called 'Vighnaharta' as he is known to take away all the problems of his devotees.

Ganesh Puja marks the occasion when Lord Ganesha leaves his abode on Mount Kailash to visit the homes of devotees and bless them with good luck and happiness all year round. This festival is celebrated with extreme devotion and religious fervour in many states of India like Maharashtra, AP, Telangana, Odisha, Gujarat, Goa, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and even outside the country.

The history of Ganpati Utsav is intrinsically linked to the birth of Lord Ganesha. As per Hindu mythology, goddess Parvati used her sandalwood paste and created Ganesha in the absence of Shiva. After this, she assigned him the

task of guarding her bathroom door. When Shiva returned home, Ganesha and Shiva got into a tiff when the former did not allow Shiva to enter home. In a fit of anger, Lord Shiva severed the head of Ganesha.

Parvati became distraught on seeing this and pleaded Shiva to bring him back to life. Shiv ji then directed his followers to search for a child who was sleeping with his head facing northwards. But they could only find an elephant's head. Hence, the baby elephant's head was attached to the body of Ganesha and he became 'Gajanan' or 'Elephant God'.

The festival is celebrated by keeping the idol of Lord Ganesha at home for 10 days during which he is worshipped with love and devotion. The festivities conclude on the 10th day or 'Visarjan' when Ganesha returns to his parents- Lord Shiva and Goddess Parvati on Mount Kailash.

Preparations for Ganesh Puja kickstart in every home a week in advance. Beautiful idols of various shapes, sizes and postures are made by sculptors and artisans. These idols are then installed at decorated pandals in homes and localities. The idol is installed after a special ritual called 'Pranapratishtha' during which priests chant special mantras marking the arrival of Lord Ganpati. During the next 10 days, Ganesha is worshipped in 16 different ways known as 'Shhodshopachara'. Offerings of his favourite sweets- laddoo and modaks are also made during this period.



On the 11th day, a ritual called 'Uttarpuja' is observed with reverence after which Lord Ganesha is given farewell. Devotees immerse the idols in water during 'Ganpati Visarjan' amid chants of 'Ganpati Bappa Morya', marking the end of the festivities.

Apart from being an auspicious religious festival, Ganesh Chaturthi has deep cultural significance too. It is a time for various colourful activities like singing, dancing and performing plays depicting the birth of Ganesha and enactment of the various legends associated with him. Families, localities and communities come together to celebrate this festival with pomp, grandeur and fanfare.

Besides, Ganesh Chaturthi is also considered an auspicious occasion for starting new business ventures and taking up of new activities. The mere name of Lord Ganesha is said to invoke good luck and activities like inauguration of new shops, businesses are undertaken on this day.

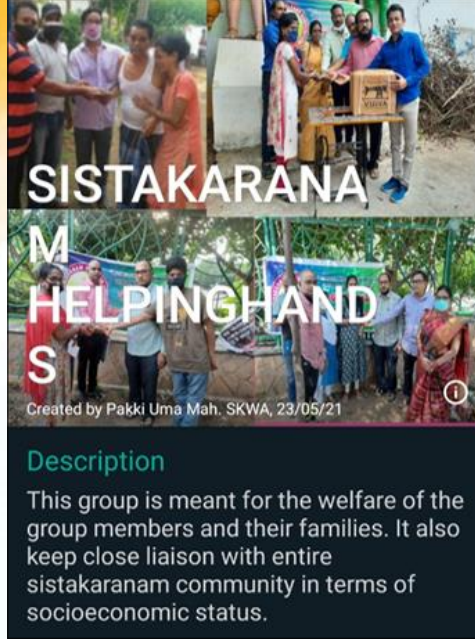

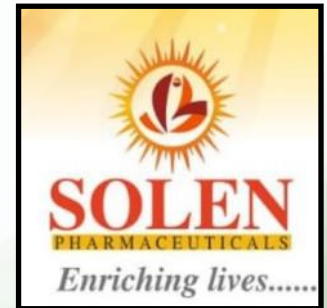

# National Eye Donation Awareness Festival

The Eye Donation Fortnight Festival is held every year from August 25th to September 8th to raise awareness and sensitize the public, through various programmes. Speaking at an awareness camp organized by DDP MP Association of India, Visakha Convener – General Physician - Dr. Kuppili Suresh Babu said that Eye donation is a great opportunity to see even after death by bringing light to lives filled with darkness. Eye donation is like a rebirth, as even after a person dies he can give his two eyes to two blind people giving them the boon of sight. Eye donation is the process of implanting the cornea, an essential part of the eye, after the person dies. While it is needed in millions, this cornea is only available in thousands. “Servendriyanam Nayanam Pradhanam” Every five minutes, one person becomes blind.

The main causes of blindness are vatast, gracoma and some other eye diseases and vitamin A deficiency. People who work in fields are affected by splinters and stones, those in factories are prone to infections due to chemicals ching their eyes, thus causing blindness.

Except for those with AIDS, blood cancer, jaundice, septicemia, viral diseases, all other age groups can donate an eye to everyone, including young and old. Also, if you call 1919 in India, the nearest eye bank will come and collect it as soon as possible. Only the black portion of the eye is collected in this process. However, due to myths and suspicions, eye donations are not happening as as planned. So let's all pledge for

eye donation together and give sight to the blind.

Durga Puja temporary pavilions are being made on the spot. Each pavilion is made in one way or another. Some of the pavilions are similar to the famous shrines and historical monuments in India. Millions are spent on the construction of pavilions. The Devi pavilions are beautifully decorated with colorful lights. Along the way, it looks like a "paradise of the underworld" with colorful lights.

Roads are crowded day and night for Devi Darshans. Bengalis do not cook at home for these five days. In every pooja pavilion, they get up early in the morning, take bath, wear colorful saris, wear ornaments, and sit in pendals looking like goddess Durga herself. Khichidi, delicious eggplant, potatoes, , pumpkin, spinach leaves, stalks and delicious kalagura are important food preparations. This kalagura is the most beloved curry of Goddess Durga. Pudding, sweets, wonderful tomato chutney, appadalu are served with that khichidi. They eat the prasadam and go in groups to see the Goddess. Along the way, they return home to hotels for fast food, idli, dosa fritters, pani puri, cool drinks, tea and coffee. Do the same thing again the second day. Relatives and friends living in

distant places flock to see the festival. Every house is rolled up and lined with relatives.

Every day a wreath is laid at the Goddess with all those who go to see her. On the tenth day, pujas and garments are offered to Goddess Durga. The women write saffron on the goddess sticks, and all those who gather there write saffron on each other's sticks during the Holi festival to please the goddess and invite "Mother to come quickly again". On the same day in our Kharagpur Ravana Maidan the tradition coming from Adi is Ravana burning. People from far and wide come to see this cremation program.

As the days change, our lifestyle changes immensely, and we leave our festivals and pubs. Durga Puja is a tradition in Bengal that has never changed. It is a privilege to see that excitement and that joy in the youth as well. Scattered friends of childhood meet in Durga Pandal. A few days spent happily remembering the days gone by.

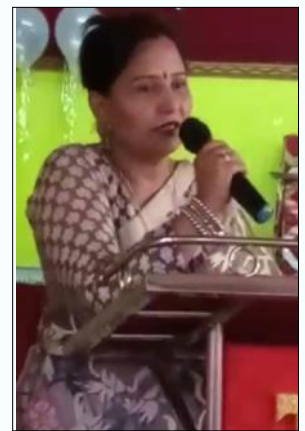

## Children Literature of our Writers



### 7 Chakras

Those that practice Kundalini yoga, are aware of chakras in the body. There are many chakras in the nadi system. Chakras are where main nadis meet together. There are 7 main chakras seen in the subtle body, namely mooladhara chakra at the base of the spine, swadisthana at the lumbar region, manipooraka at the abdomen below the diaphragm, anahata chakra at the heart region, visudhi at the center of the throat, ajna chakra near the third eye, and sahasrara at the top of the head. These chakras are ruled by Ganesha, Brahma, Vishnu, Rudra, Ishvara, Ardha nareeshwara, Shiva respectively. The goal of yoga in the shakta parampara such as Srividhya, Kaula is to activate these chakras. Ida, Pingala go through these chakras, and the energy flow is usually blocked in between the chakras. These are called knots. When the Kundalini is activated by Guru, it flows naturally upwards to brahma randra, at the top of the head. By removing the knots, the chakras are activated one by one, and the energy flows (penetrates) through these chakras smoothly.

Depending on the parampara, mantras are used to activate these chakras. In Kundalini yoga, Chakradhyana is a practice to activate these centers. In Chakra dhyana, beejsharas lam, vam, ram, yam, hum, om, aum is pronounced to activate and open these chakras.

Different tantric sadhanas are used to activate the Kundalini which is normally in dormant state near mooladhara chakra. During the birth, the cosmic energy is stored in the human body in coiled manner, symbolically represented as a serpent in coiled manner. Srividhya sadhana practices mantras instead of Chakra dhyana, to activate Kudalini.

It is very common to have dreams of serpents during the time kundalini is awakened or has just awakening. This is a very positive sign. The chakras from muladhara to sahasrara are respectively governed by different yoginis such as sakini, kakini, lakini, rakini, dakini, hakini, yakini. Kundalini Yoga was a secret tantric practice in olden days only passed on along the lineage. However, in modern world this knowledge is openly available. This also creates confusion among practitioners. Awakening Kundalini, without proper guidance of qualified Guru could be very critical and can create crisis. However once, the Kundalini activates, it automatically guides the Sadhak towards balancing the immense energy that gets generated and towards a spiritually fulfilling life.

When Kundalini flows, one undergoes an unexplainable blissful experience, that he or she cannot give away the experience for anything else in the world.

Those, whose brahma randra (sahasrara) has opened can take in the cosmic energy into their body directly from the brahma randra.

## What is Gotram?

Notice how our ancestral system was established according to science.

You are sitting in worship, Every time, do you know why the priest asks about your tribe? Do you think it's chaotic because you do not know ??

mines the gender of the person (resulting cell). During pregnancy the resulting cell XX chromosomes becomes a girl, while XY becomes a boy. In XY - from X mother, And Y takes from the father. This Y is unique and It does not meet in X. So in XY, Y suppresses X, so the son gets Y chromosomes. It only goes between males. (From father to son and grandson to great grandson ... so ..).

Women will never get a Y. Y therefore plays a key role in genetics in identifying genealogy. Women will never get Y so the female tribe will belong to her husband. So his daughter's tribe changes after marriage.

Marriages between same tribes increase the risk of genetic disorders ...

Inherited Y chromosomes should not be one according to tribe Because it activates defective result cells .... If this continues, it will reduce the size and strength of the Y chromosome, which is crucial for male creation. In some cases, it will be destroyed.

Swagotra is a method of trying to prevent defects and protect the Y chromosome. That is why marriage between Swagotris is forbidden ... a wonderful bio-science tribe created by our Maharishis. This is undoubtedly the treasure of Indian heritage.

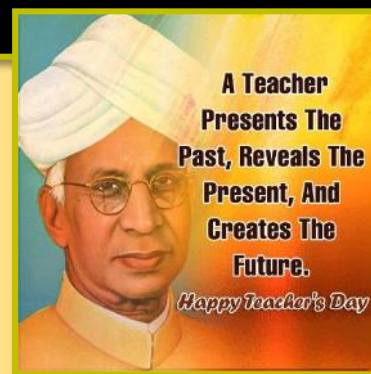
### School Staff Felicitate Correspondent

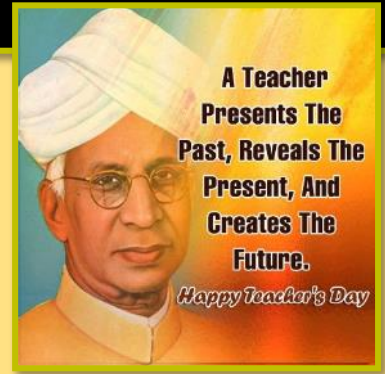

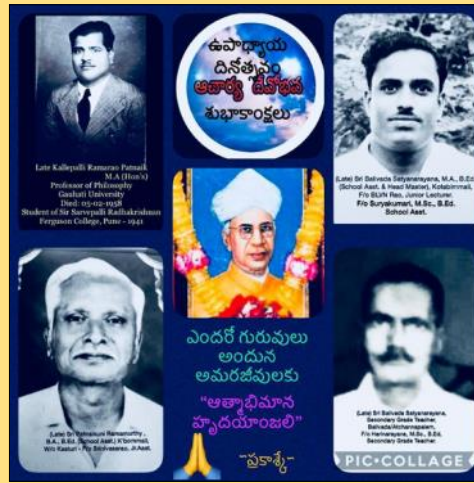

Later he completed his B. Ed and joined at G Madugula as School Asst. Four years later he served as MEO (Mandal Education Officer).

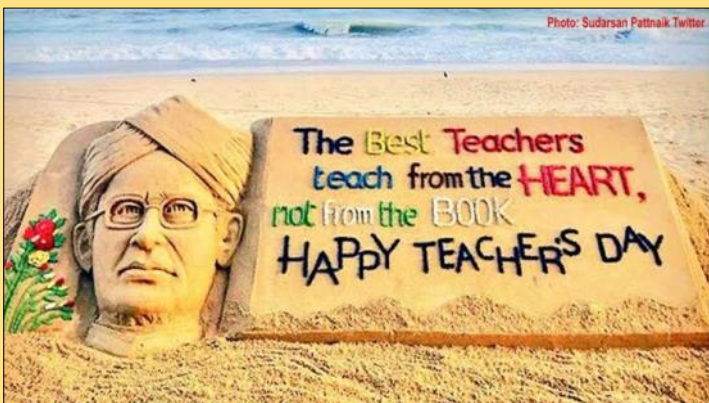
After working for some timer as a Head Master, he retired in 2000. A gemstone among Sistakranams. True India. Venkata Rama Rao.
