INTERVIEW

A Scouting Jewel in Community Service

Lekha could meet the pearl of our community who received awards from four Indian Presidents. Are you wondering who is that? If so, the person you need to know is Sri Behara Ramesh Patnaik. He served Indian Railways for 39 years and retired in 2009 as Personnel Officer in Raipur. Our conversation went as follows:

We are eager to know about your awards. Kindly share your memories with us.

I am glad to share that I was felicitated and conferred with the most prestigious and coveted awards from his Excellency President of India consequently 4 times. Received the "President's Scout" award in 1967 by H.E. Dr S. Radhakrishnan, "Silver Star" in 2001 by H.E. Sri. K.R. Narayanan, "Bar to Silver Star" in 2007 by H.E. Dr APJ Abdul Kalam and finally the Country's Highest Scout Medallion "Silver Elephant" in 2015 by H.E. Sri. Pranab Mukherjee.

World Scout Bureau, Switzerland conferred the title "Order of the Byline—Writer Extraordinary" in 2003 in appreciation of my services in heading International Press Centre at World Jamboree in Thailand and for my creative writings, interviewing various country heads, Kings, Crown Princes etc.

I also received state honours from heads of different countries Bhutan, Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Thailand.

What are the challenges you faced in your life's journey?

The journey sticking with values and virtues is not that easy. You have to confront odd situations and some times get badly demoralised. But once you conquer through it, you have full satisfaction in life that you did your share of the job. When I look back and see, I have reached my goals but still need to march ahead to achieve them fully.

Who is behind your success?

My beloved wife Late B. Leela and my two lovely kids.

What are the countries you have visited?

Afghanistan, Bhutan, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Philippines etc.

What about social responsibility activities?

I got the opportunity to take extensive responsibility and rendered voluntary services through scouting movement and trained thousands of children and adult leaders in Character Building and Citizenship ideologies throughout India and abroad. Trained hun-

dreds of Teachers, Principles, Education officers of KVS, NVS, Government and Private institutes and conducted Commissioner's training to railways and government officers. Launched Adult Literary courses, Leprosy Eradication campaign, Rehabilitation of Rag pickers, Slum children, various Community Service and Development projects organized, worked on National integration, Messenger of Peace, Free Being Me (a program for girl child in building body confidence) etc. projects throughout the country.

Tell us about your services to community.

Way back in 1981, the Sistakaranam families residing in Bhilai, Durg and Raipur were brought under one umbrella to strengthen community bondage. After Chhattisgarh state separated from Madhya Pradesh, CGSKA, a state body has been formed and various activities both at state and national level were organized. I initiated to strengthen the bondage of Sistakaranams residing outside of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana and in this process, the All India Pravasa ndhra Sista Karanam Association (AIPSKA) was established. Our caste - My thoughts

Heartfelt greetings to all relatives.

This article is not intended for anyone in particular, just wishing for a change in those to whom it may apply... with much hope that our community prospers.

Our caste is Sistakaranam, (Sista is the opposite of the word evil) our family is Sistakaranam. Our caste, our customs, culture, traditions are ideal and exemplary for many castes. Whether they say it openly or not, they do follow us.

What we see in most castes, is that they appear to be mass with words but speak building relationship with others. It evokes a lot of love and affection. This is exceedingly rare in our caste (perhaps with an idea in mind that we are a little bit forward). Even if you do not know the lineage, do not know one's age, do not know the caste or gotram, it would be nice to call the people of one's caste affectionately as elder brother, younger brother, uncle, cousin, aunt, grandfather, grandmother, and so on.

In our caste, individual members seem to dislike each other, but not explicitly. The remarks are subtle, there is tit for tat, there are satires on the words of others, they undermine some when talking to others, perhaps the thought that if a fellow caste member is helped, he will unnecessarily get better. Another thing here is that there are those who do not even thank someone who has helped with an issue, and there are

those who tell outsiders that nothing has been done. Only when we abandon this malady, will we certainly prosper.

Family disputes are on the rise due to a lack of proper understanding. There are in-laws who torture their daughters-in-law, there are daughters-in-law who terrorize their in-laws, and there are ladies who forget what financial trouble their parents went through for the match and torture their in-laws like in a frying pan without oil.

There are mothers-in-law who send their sons to jobs and torment daughters-in-law, and there are those who lack the common sense that the better half should be taken home. There are some who don't distribute assets to children denying them a chance to meet their needs. There are those who dictate that a joint family is a must, when there is suggestion to start a separate family. In many households, all our caste relatives are facing many problems like this. The main demonic reason for all this is mainly financial circumstances, there are some who earn a few lakhs a month, yet give just a thousand or two a month to the parents. You, who are earning lakhs, can not give at least ten thousand rupees to parents who have no income. (In a different religion, one should donate 20% per month to their teacher of the monthly income they earn, i.e. give 1/5 share of his earnings, they actually are giving that).

I request caste elders, intellectuals, lawyers,

politicians, legal analysts, educators, medical professionals to come forward and support the caste and those in the caste, for the betterment

of the caste and the people of the caste. Many versatile and talented teachers, faculty, intellectuals, lawyers, revenue, police department, if you care for fellow members, come forward to as mentors and help the community. You may forget the day when you resolved some-one's problems, but the beneficiaries will remember you for the rest of their lives.

If you have enough income or more (this is known only to those who are satisfied) / Property, if you want to make a donation to someone, do it directly, do not give because it will be published in a newsletter, or will be posted in WhatsApp groups, do not give to mediators it is better to give yourself directly to the beneficiaries, for example, pay a one-time fee to learn tailoring or computer work for a person in poverty, who will never forget the good you did. One also has the psychological satisfaction of having helped in this way.

- 4) Do not put photos or sending details about the donation in groups. It causes jealousy.
- 5) If you want to reveal the names of the donors..just give the names..don't say anywhere how much money they have given.
- 6) Note in particular. you should donate only if you like it well. Or if you trust it well. However If you have any doubt do not donate Remember that there is nothing which compels you to donate.

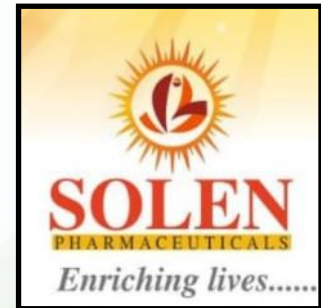

Durga Puja Celebrations in West Bengal

Durga Puja is the one of the most important festivals celebrated in West Bengal, in honor of Goddess Durga during the period of Navaratri.

It is celebrated for 10 days, however starting from the sixth day until the ninth day the Pandals with grand idols of Goddess Durga are open for visitors. The tenth day, also known as Vijaya Dashami marks the Visarjan (immersion in water) of the idol with grand celebrations and processions. The last five days of the festival are most important. They are respectively called "Shoshthi", "Saptami", "Ashtami",

"Nabami" and "Dashami". Each of these days has a special puja and the evening has what is called "shondhi pujo." The air is filled with the sound of "dhakis" or drummers playing a special drum and the priests chanting the holy mantras. There is a special dance called "dhunuchi naach" with small containers of burning and fragrant coal and incense to perform the rituals before the goddess.

It is believed that the more idols people visit, the more the goddess will be pleased to grant blessings upon the people. So, all over the state people visit various idols

from early morning till late at night and call this "thakur darshan" or seeking the blessings. On the last day, Dussehra which is also known as Vijaya Dashami when "Victory of Good over Evil" is represented by burning the Idol of evil Ravana.

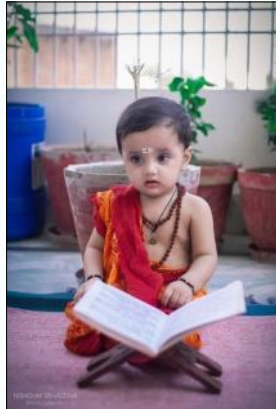

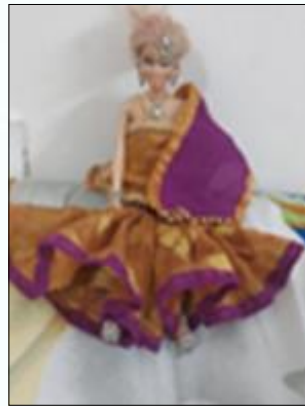

The great man who fell into obscurity

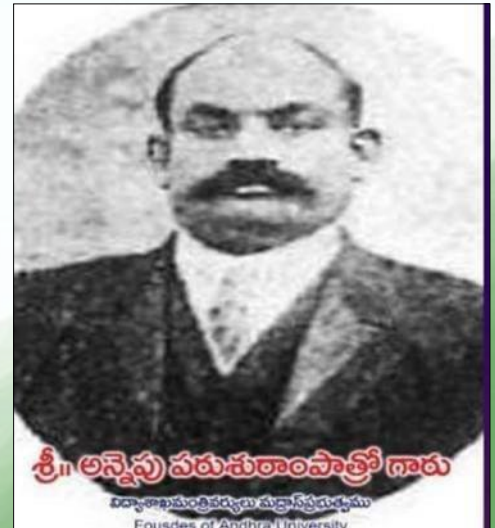
Late Sri Annepu Parushurampatro Garu (1857-1946)

Rao Bahadur Sir Annepu Parushuram Dhas Patro, a great man who said that poverty eradication is possible only with the development of education. His services unselfishly as a social reformer and minister are memorable. Unfortunately, politicians and rulers ignored his services. That is why others know about him. Very low. Papadu Patro and Paramma were born in 1857 in the village of Langipalle near Barampur in the old Ganjam district (including the present day Srikakulam district) in the role of Annepu Parushuram Das, who received the title of Rao Bahadur Sir from the British rulers.

In his childhood education, Shabas seemed to be born into a farming family. B. A., B. L. in Madras. Done. He was the first graduate of the Kalinga community. Upon completion of the degree he was elected President of the Ganjam District People's Association. He remained a member of the Madras Leg-

islative Council until 1920. The people in the rural areas where the minimum requirements were met were shocked by the hardships. He called for the spread of education before poverty could be eradicated. Worked in rural self-governing bodies and worked for the spread of education for 26 years.

The town of Vizag presided over the Social and Industrial Conference. From 1921 to 1927 he served as the Minister of Education, Excise and Public Registration in the Joint State of Madras and did many development works. He favored all sections of the society irrespective of caste. As a result of his efforts, Andhra University was established in 1926. Elected President of the South India Liberal Foundation. He was elected as the leader of the Justice Party, which protested against the domination of the Brahmins and worked for the development of the backward classes. Served as Chairman of the Madras Simon Reforms Committee. Elected Chairman of the All-



Party Committee in March 1930, the Government took note of the plight of the people. He thoroughly studied the rural economy and authored a book, Rural Economics. Elected Alternate Member to the Twelfth Meeting of the League of Nations in 1931

Vivekachudamani

Vivekachudamani is a treatise written by Adi Shankaracharya on advaita vedanta. It is jewel of knowledge on the atma vichara. It encourages the reader to realize the real from unreal. It emphasizes that the 3 gunas, and the 5 sheaths of body are not real. True seeker need to know that all sensory objects are unreal. The witness the satchidananda Brahman is the real self, and one should always have the awareness of this self. The path to self knowledge is by maintaining dispassion on all objects, and knowing that self alone is real. Knowing that self is different from buddhi, and it is superimposed upon atman, which alone is real. Atman alone shines, and illuminates different forms and objects. All objects are unreal and are mere superpositions. One shall maintain discrimination between self and non-self. Egoism is to be dropped. Identifying one with the false identities to be dropped and one should identify him self with Atman, which is the eternal reality.



Giridhar is a spiritual seeker graced by realized Gurus Shri Badarinayanji and Leslie Temple Thurston.

In order to liberate from the samsara of the birth and death cycles, one must drop all false identities that are changing. The real identity atman is unborn, unchanging, indivisible and is the essence of all. The universe is simply superposition of false attributes. Prakriti is bound by maya, and one should see that self is all illuminating and source of all, and is oneness indivisible. This oneness is absolute brahman, satchidananda swaroopam. One dwelves in the atman is filled with bliss, and drops all the egoic impressions of worldly objects. One dwelves in this way maintains nirvikalpa samadhi and is known to be liberated. He simply lives to fulfill the prarabdha karma. He does not engage in worldly activities and becomes jeevan mukta. He is engrossed in self and knows that he is self of all universe.

Atma vicara is a path that takes one to realize the reality from the unreal. For a common practitioner sravana, manana and nidha dhyasa of the truths presented in viveka chudamani are prescribed. Vivekachudamani clearly presents that Brahman is the only truth and substratum of the universe, the world is illusory and there is ultimately no difference between Brahman and individual self.

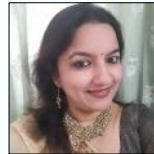
