## Sistakaranam Community's Appeal

A humble request to the candidates of various political parties who won or will win the elections. Our Sistakaranam community appeals to fulfill their just aspirations.

- 1) The long pending demand for inclusion in the OBC list should be fulfilled.
- 2) In the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, Sistakaranams in BC-D should be repositioned in BC-A.
- 3) Unemployed Sistakaranams should be given jobs or unemployment benefits.
- 4) Pensions should be granted to single women, old age and disabled persons among Sistakaranams.
- 5) Community hall should be constructed with student hostel facilities and reading room facilities in cities like Visakhapatnam, Hyderabad, Vijayawada for the Sistakaranams to provide accommodation to the poor Sistakaranam students of rural areas. In fact, Sri Golla Baburaogaru, ex-MLA and now Honorable Member of Rajya Sabha, gave assurances about this demand.
- 6) The parties should allocate the posts of MLC and MLA without limiting Sistakaranams to the posts of ward members, councillors, corporators and sarpanches. The parties should encourage Sistakaranams political development rather than limiting them to jobs.
- 7) Houses should be given to homeless poor Sistakaranams.

8) A paved road should be sanctioned for a distance of only one km to Karanalapet where a single family lives. They should be provided with medical and health facilities at least in nearby Dandulakshmpuram.

9) Adequate assistance should be provided to Sistakaranams residing in the coastal areas and tribal areas.

10) Interest free loans should be granted for setting up small businesses for those without any vocational background.

11) The Sistakaranam students who drop out due to poverty should be supported and their education should be completed.

12) Special shopping complexes should be constructed for Sistakaranams and shops should be allotted to them at low rent.

13) Employment should be provided in the native place to all those who leave their native place and migrate for livelihood. Cultivated land should be provided with D pattas. The National Employment Scheme should provide suitable self-employment schemes for those who are unemployed and strengthen their financial resources to open up their livelihood.

It is our decision to vote for victory of only those parties who see that the Sistakaranam people live with dignity in the society. We request the candidates of the parties to consider our requests and help us.

## Interview

### Strong will a must for success

*Reading and writing a letter was the qualification for ladies in yesteryears. At that time girls' education was less. Gosha was in practice in our Sistakaranam community. While reading the sentence in Telugu textbook as Sarojini Naidu graduated, that message was deeply rooted in her heart. She didn't know what was the graduation means, but her desire was grown along with her. She achieved her dream. Lekha is talking about Smt. Rayagada Rajeswari Patnaik. Let us talk to her.*



#### Please share about your parents.

My father was a Village Karanam. He died when I was young. My mother was a housewife. Our mother memorized Bhagavad-Gita along with mahatyam of it. Mantrapushmam, Rukmini Kalyanam, Gajendra Moksham, Naladamayanti Charitra, some poems from shatakas were memorized my mother and in early hours she used sing all these as an awakening without looking into the book.

She used to heal little ailments of kids with the kitchen tips. Whatever the women in the village need, they come to her as Patnayaramamma and take advice. To wear paayie at home, to send girl to the in-laws's place, to bring home daughter-in-law, aksharabyasam, and for everything they used to ask her for muhurtham.

#### Share with us about your career.

Because of my eldest brother, I could study B.Sc. and B.Ed. I got a job at an English medium school in Vizianagaram. I am life sciences teacher and finally retired as headmistress, government girls' high school in Saluru and retired there in 2007 after attaining 58 years.

#### What about your social activities?

Since my childhood, my desire was to work as a teacher and make good students. After my graduation, I got permanent job in project office of the Women and Child Welfare department. But I left it and joined in B.Ed. training and became teacher. I was helping poor pupil, including our caste pupil by giving them uniforms, note books, and paying fees for 10th class students.

After my retirement, I provided slates and books to 20 adults belonging to the Kuraku-

la caste and taught them at night for 2 years. I succeeded in making them to read Trinadha Vrathakalpanam.

In my village, Arikathota, I donated a small piece of land and money and built Sri Satya Sai Bhajan Mandali with the help of another madam and some others. Even today I go there on Baba gari birthday and distribute 100 blankets and do annasantarpana.

#### Your message to our community please.

We have intelligence, courage, adventure, patience and hardworking spirit to excel in any field. Adults should inform the children and make them interested.

#### Your comments on Lekha.

Congratulations to all the admin team who started the Lekha, especially to Shri JVS Chandrababu. Your service to Kalaamathalli and our community is truly unique. I am happy to find a place in Lekha.

### Sunshade shelter by 'Memunnam Seva Sanstha'

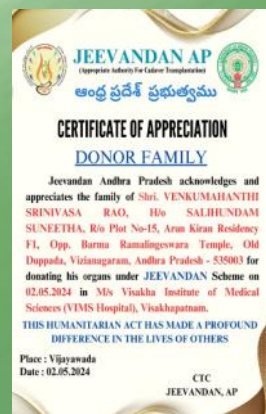



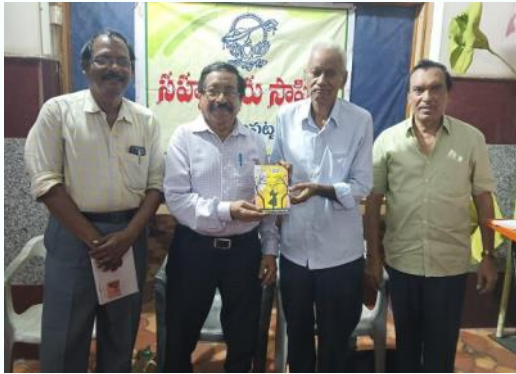

## Sekharamantri Prabhakar in Visakha Literary History – Leader Publication Essay

An article in 'Visakha Literary History', featured in 'Leader' magazine, elaborated on Shekharamantri Prabhakar's poetry and his contributions to literature.

Shekharamantri Prabhakara Rao, praised by the esteemed teacher and poet Chitrakavi Atreya as the "heartfelt heart of Shekharamantri," is a distinguished poet. Unlike many who write from the comfort of their homes, Prabhakara Rao viewed literary service as a social responsibility. He actively immersed himself in the field, managing a literary organization with discipline. He maintained connections with hundreds of literary figures and institutions across Telugu-speaking regions, shining like a pinnacle in

organization founded by Chitrakavi Atreya. He has published four poetry collections: 'Kanti Kapothalu', 'Kranthi Kiranalu', 'Sri Sai Padapushpalu', and 'Prabhakiranalu', with a sequel, 'Kirana Kimmiram', forthcoming. His verse includes mini-poems, haikus, and nano-poems.

His first collection, 'Kanti Kapothalu', received acclaim from Dr. C. Narayana Reddy and a critical review by Dr. Addepalli. Dwani Shastri hailed Shekharamantri as a socially conscious poet. His works, rich in meaning despite their brevity, feature wit, irony, and satire.

Some of his notable lines include:

"Woman Chairperson: The chair is husband's, the woman is the person" – a political reality.

"Those who made sacrifices are being sacrificed" – a poignant social critique on old age homes."

"The rain left behind many mirrors for the vanity of the tree lassies" – depicting

time-devouring demon, highlighting the loss of experiences and knowledge due to excessive entertainment. His poems resonate with his heart's rhythm, offering homage to departed greats with heartfelt elegies.

Shekharamantri's 'Prabhakiranalu' is an experimental work. As the poet himself describes, these rays are like aphorisms, embodying the truths of human life, teachings of gurus, gems from great poets, and his own expressions. Initially shared daily on a WhatsApp group, these rays were compiled into a collection of 1,000 based on the requests of his literary friends. Though not directly comparable to the musings of Chalam or the songs of Lata, this collection represents his unique intellectual journey. The book was blessed by Sri Siddheswarananda Bharati Swami as a cultural lamp for universal welfare, while another spiritual leader, Dr. Chilakapati Vijaya Raghavacharyulu, praised it, saying, "There is no rigidity in words, no difficulty in conveying thoughts, not detached from personal experiences or worldly matters. These are bundles of words, gardens of thoughts, and plays of ideas," highlighting the success of Shekharamantri's endeavor. Acharya Vedula praises that the sayings in this are not just maxims, but poetically manifest into a modern epic. English pundit Premananda Kumar congratulated Shekharamantri as a friendly sibling. Acharya Malaya Vasini described these reflections as Kirana Kimmiram, and Prabhakar decided on that name for the second stage of Prabha Kiranalu.

As a devotee of Sathya Sai Baba, Shekharamantri also published 'Sri Sai Padapushpalu', a collection of songs suitable for singing, which was published by Prabhakaram Sahiti Peetham under the guidance of Acharya G.V.S.L. Narasimha Raju.

Recently, Shekharamantri has also ventured into poetry writing, contributing five tetagitas (a form of Telugu poetry) to a collection published by the Aurobindo Society in Hanumakonda.

His extensive connections with various cultural, spiritual, and social organizations have led to numerous honors from government departments and literary cultural institutions.

Shekharamantri, a poet with a profound social consciousness, questioned poets writing romantic poetry with his debut poem, urging them to focus on the suffering of the poor. His literary journey spans over four decades.

Born on October 6, 1947, in Tuni to Narasimhamaurthy and Subhavati, he retired as Deputy Manager of Quality Control at BHPV in Visakhapatnam. His wife is Tarineelata.

Shekharamantri demonstrated his literary prowess as the long-time secretary and current president of Saharudaya Sahiti, an or-

nature's beauty with emotional depth."

His poetry reflects a social voice regardless of the form it takes, addressing various societal facets. Spiritual leader Atreya praised 'Kranthi Kiranalu' for its uplifting and heartfelt expression of Shekharamantri's noble sentiments. The poem "Tree Mother" beautifully equates a tree's love for humans to a mother's love. One can perceive a poet whose heart aspires to aromatize the whole world with the good sandalwood of humanity.

Shekharamantri's poetry also critiques modern life, like his depiction of television as a

### A Noose to Respiration - Awareness on Lung Cancer - Dr. Kuppili Suresh Babu

One-third of cancer deaths worldwide are caused by lung cancer. This issue poses a significant challenge for India, which is progressing competitively with other nations. Breathing is essential for life, and without it, survival is impossible. The lungs play a critical role in this process.

Lung cancer presents a severe threat to these vital organs. The increasing levels of pollution and the number of smokers are contributing to the rise in lung cancer deaths.

In India, lung cancer ranks just below breast cancer in prevalence. It occurs due to the uncontrolled growth of cells in the lungs, which can also spread to surrounding organs. This disease is more common in men than in women. Many people might mistake its symptoms for tuberculosis due to a lack of awareness.

The causes of lung cancer include tobacco and its products, accounting for 70 to 80 percent of cases. Additionally, exposure to asbestos, urani-

um, and arsenic, particularly for mine workers, and industrial and environmental pollution, along with passive smoking (inhaling smoke indirectly), also contribute. Individuals with a family history of cancer are at higher risk.

Symptoms include a persistent cough, coughing up blood, wheezing, chest pain, headaches, vomiting, gradual weight loss, pain in the bones and muscles, severe fatigue, and changes in the voice.

Diagnostic tests for lung cancer include chest X-rays, chest CT scans, bronchoscopy with biopsy, complete blood count (CBC) test, ESR test, and various specialized blood tests, as well as biopsy exams.

Prevention involves avoiding exposure to tobacco and its products entirely, adopting a healthier lifestyle, staying away from those who smoke, maintaining a distance from vehicular pollution and industrial pollution, staying away from dust and smoke, living in a healthy environment, con-

suming a nutritious diet, and engaging in regular exercise.

Treatment methods vary. Early detection makes treating this disease much easier.

Initially, if diagnosed, it can be treated with surgery. Radiotherapy, chemotherapy, lung cancer being a silent killer or a noiseless assassin, targeted therapy, and whatever else may be necessary. If diagnosed from the beginning, it does not become fatal.

Every year, the world observes World Lung Cancer Day to raise awareness about lung cancer. As part of it, the P.M.P. Association of India District Convener Visakha, popular Doctor - Kuppili Suresh Babu thoroughly educated people on the causes, symptoms, prevention, and treatment of lung cancer.

### Born with a purpose – Late Behara Kalyan Ram – Visakhapatnam



Very few among Sistakaranams are born with a purpose. One such person is Late Behara Kalyan Ram. He was a Visakhapatnam resident. Retired as District Audit Officer in Joint Andhra Pradesh State Audit Department. His parents were

Late Srimati Ranganayakamma and Late Sri Behara Jagannadhaswamygaru. He was born on 10-05-1940. Studied SSLC in Board High School, Jami, Vizianagaram District. Later, he studied PUC at Messrs. AVN College, a famous college in Visakhapatnam. He worked in the State Audit Department from 12-03-1962 to 31-05-1998. Retired after 58 years as per the then rules.

He played an active role in Sistakaranam associations from 1969. On the encouragement of the founding members of Visakhapatnam District Sistakaranam Association Late Dr. MV Narasinga Rao and Late KR Pathak, he joined the associations and served continuously. Served as executive committee member of Andhra Pradesh State Sistakaranam Association and All India Sistakaranam Association. Participated in the BC-D movement for Sistakaranams and achieved success with prominent leaders. Appeared before various commissions. Actively participated in Justice Puttuswamy Commission, Justice Dalwa Subrahmanyam Commission and in public hearings and surveys held till 2008. Finally, in 2009, Sistakara-

nams was included in BC-D.

He served as Associate President in the Allipuram Sistakaranam Community Hall Construction Committee and successfully undertook the construction with the team members. As a philanthropist, Kalyan Ram also donated Rs 5000 in the name of their son.

He also served as the Treasurer of Alindia Sishtakarana Sangam from 2000-2006. He later held the post of Working President.

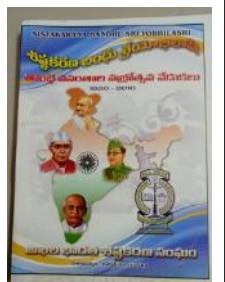
When I was working in Indian Bank in Vijayawada, Late Kalyan Ram came to Vijayawada and gave advice and suggestions in reviving the Krishna Zilla Sistakaranam Association under the leadership of Sri Baliwada Shivakumar Patnaik for the 200 Sistakaranam families there. He advised the association and helped to organize many Mahasabhas, BC Vijayotsavasabhas and service programs. Even today, the leaders of that community have not forgotten Kalyan Ram.

The reason to say he was born for a purpose is that he spent a lot of effort and collected a few hundred pages of information and published an encyclopedia called Sishtakarana Bandhusreyobhilashi. The book was launched on the occasion of the 90th anniversary of the All India Sistakaranam Association (1920-2010). Inspired by our ancestors who published the book Bandhuseva from Barampuram in 1930, he started writing this book and was able to complete it in 2010. The release of such good information is only possible for those born with a purpose. That is why we recognize Late Behara Kalyan Ram as such a person. In fact, he is also an inspiration

for our Lekha team members, for their untiring efforts to publish Sistakaranam Lekha on the first Sunday of every month with the information of Sistakaranams in the country and abroad.

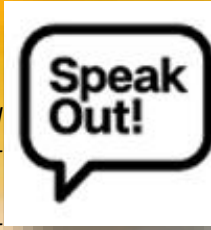

## Biksha



Girdhar is a spiritual seeker graced by realized Gurus Shri Badarinayanji and Leslie Temple Thurston.

Budhist practitioners go for alms so that they support their physical body with necessary food and nutrition. In worldly life begging is not a good practise and unfair on others that are working for living. In spiritual life begging is not bad. One that likes to progress in spiritual life, needs to go beyond the preconceived notions of begging.

Begging not only applies to physical survival but also to spiritual upliftment. When one goes beyond doership based thinking, begging or giving becomes easy to understand. When one is not the doer he or she is not the giver, and he or she is just an instrument of Gods work to deliver required support to the one that is begging.

In esoteric spiritual life Biksha is an important aspect and to be given some thinking about deeper meaning. For one that has lost the sense of doership or ownership, what does he own? and what is his and who is giving? In this vast creation of God what belongs to us? When the sense of doership is not there, neither begging nor giving do not change ones centered self and ego of doership doesn't kick in while doing either. When one goes beyond the duality of begging and giving, one transcends beyond relationships and archetypes like boss, and subordinate.

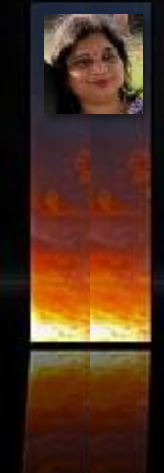

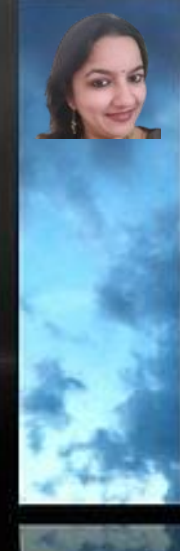
