Hyderabad is where Sistakaranam Ikyavedika has its roots, and, in its 4 years of existence, if there is one discordant note that we have experienced, it is that our community in the twin cities is not one cohesive unit.

In fact, let us be honest, it is two distinct units that exist in Hyderabad.

I will not explicitly identify the units, but let me describe them in terms of their strengths. One unit has rich legacy dating back to several decades, has done yeomen service to the community in the undivided AP state, and has given us several stalwarts who have been the torch bearers for our community. The other unit has been active for a decade and half, has been able to connect with Sistakaranams nation-wide, indeed world-wide, has political connections at a high level, and is known for encouraging new talent which is why it is a comparatively more flourishing unit today that brings together the majority of our community in all its activities.

Sistakaranam Ikyavedika, on the other hand, is sometimes mistaken to be a 3rd unit but, as we have always maintained, we are not an association of people, we are just a platform to bring together all Sistakaranams (hence the term "Ikyavedika"). And, we do that through our newsmagazine 'Lekha', our website & social media platforms, and other occasional activities.

We believe that, we have been able to do that at the national and world level, but we can't claim the same success when it comes to Hyderabad! The two distinct units continue to exist and, somehow, cannot come together.

When we approach a stalwart of one unit to publish an interview in Lekha they oblige us,, but the other unit keeps postponing the same. An idea to have our own premises is mooted by one unit, and Ikyavedika tries to bring together both units to work together for the cause proposing a meeting, but the same is postponed giving one excuse or the other.

The biggest casualty in all this are certain individuals, with proven track record of service to community, who are now maintaining a low key because they feel one unit may get offended if they participate in activities that are related to the other unit. Our community progress is impeded because of this.

Can the leaders of both units please take note of this? Ikyavedika is always ready to facilitate anything. And, we are not going to give up. We will keep pestering both units to come together, After all, isn't a united community a necessary condition for its own progress?

AISKA endeavours to bring all its community members under one umbrella. Thanks to trending technology and social media like Internet, Facebook, Whatsapp, etc., we are able to leverage and network. A lot is happening online on real time basis to exchange information from any corner of the globe. 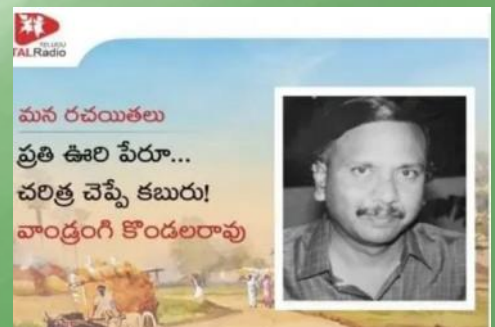

Kondalarao authoritatively explained the need to know the names of the villages and the history behind the names of the villages. He said that it is an indescribable feeling when we see the nameboards of the towns along the way while traveling. He described Village Toponymy, which is a major part of Onomastics. He elaborated the history behind the names of villages like Deerjasi, Kaki, Bhojanam, Ponduru, Kappatralla etc. He explained how migration and other reasons formed many sma ename villages, with examples of people with family names. He touched upon villages formed with the names of gods, village deities, trees and animals. He said that knowledge of village name is like an endless story. He explained the uniqueness of Ooru-Peru (AP), Grama Namalu (AP), Ponduru Maro Bandar books written by him, as part of Toponymy studies. He revealed his research on two per month being published in Visakha Sanskriti monthly magazine for the last six years. Fabric Paintings on traditional wear by Smt. Jyotsna



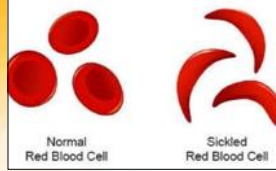

Awareness of Sickle Cell Anemia- Dr. Kuppili Suresh Babu

This Sickle cell anemia is a hereditary blood disease. The anemia is caused by complications in hemoglobin. Due to this, red blood cells will not be in their original shape, but in the shape of the sickle. This means that blood circulation does not go smoothly. In that case, clotting is likely to increase. RBC gets its red color from hemoglobin.



This hemoglobin plays a key part in absorbing oxygen through the lungs and supplying it to all parts through circulation.

Causes...

The primary cause of sickle cell anemia is HBB mutation. It is of two types. One is the autosomal recessive pattern. The disease is inherited, meaning that one will not have sickle cell symptoms of anemia if parents do not have the condition. A single gene is affected instead of two genes. They display only a few symptoms. This is called sickle cell trait. Normally red blood cells live for 90 days to 120 days, but in sickle cell anemia the blood cells live for only 10 to 20 days.

Symptoms...

Fatigue, blood clotting, anemia, prolonged jaundice, pain in legs and arms, swelling, pale body due to anemia, spleen swelling, stroke, vision impairment, emaciation. Implications of this are - chronic pain, stroke, osteogenic bone necrosis, gallstones, leg swelling, blood clots, polyarterial hypertension, kidney problems, convulsions, Priapism disease.

Diagnosis...

Peripheral smear, electroporosis, blood transfusion, bone marrow transplantation, gene therapy. Any of these sickle cell anemias are better diagnosed and treated at an early stage. There is no permanent cure for this.

The PMP Association of India - Visakha District Convener - Social Practitioners - Dr. Kuppili Suresh Babu elaborated on the above as part of community service. Just for awareness.

Symptoms 3 hours before a heart attack, and STR

According to renowned cardiologist Professor Chokkalingam:-

If one suspects a heart attack, he should not be allowed to walk; Climbing or descending stairs shall not be permitted; Do not go to the hospital in an auto. Any one of these can make it difficult for the patient to survive. Our brain is the organ that can sense a heart attack three hours in advance. Even if there is a small disturbance in our body's activities, the brain immediately alerts us. Diabetics may find it difficult to experience this precaution.

If we see a man or woman falling down at any wedding ceremony, in public places or at home, we should immediately pay attention to them. But they can say that nothing happened to them, I am fine. We also should not let it go easily as something bitter. We should tell them to do STR so that we can clearly know their health when they see the warning that the brain is announcing.

STR stands for:

SMILE

TALK

RAISE BOTH HANDS

Such programs should be done. They must do all three correctly! If they don't do any of these right, the problem is big! Immediate hospitalization can prevent death. Doctors say that if you come to the hospital within 3 hours after knowing this symptom, most of the loss of life can be prevented.

A recent medical study says that if they do all three well and correctly, an important step should be taken to further confirm.

They should be asked to stick out their tongues.

If they stretch their tongue straight, it can be confirmed that they are normal and healthy, if they don't stretch it straight i.e. if it is bent to the right or left side any time within the next 3 hours, they may have an attack.

We request that everyone who reads this should educate everyone with a humanitarian perspective without any caste or religious differences.

Vidura's morals

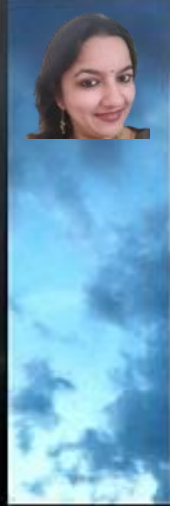
