wealth so that they can help poor Sistasakaranams. Wherever possible they should stop serving under other people and should become entrepreneurs, businessmen and industrialists. All the best.

Try to use scarce resources like money earned in a judicious way, avoiding waste expenditure and use it for acquiring assets and wealth. Restore the past lost glory of Sistasakaranams.

Interview

Destiny is in our hands

A Sistakaranam lady against all odds of life including a life threat, came out of suicidal thought and carved her life and stood as a role model to many. Her narrations make us to understand how some situations with strong desire to do, takes one to an unbelievable world. Let's listen to the inner words of Smt. Dr. Kantimahanti Suchitra Balakrishna.

Please share about you and your career.

My father was a railway employee in Ranchi. I studied up to 12th class at Ranchi. I did B.Com. from Andhra University. I was the first lady in the country to do hardware engineering from Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) in the year 2007. JSS comes under the Ministry of skill development & entrepreneurship, Government of India.

I was a student of JSS and then became a teacher in JSS itself. Now, I am Vice-Chairman of JSS for Vizianagaram district unit. I am proud of what I have achieved. I would like to express my gratitude to my sisters Tanuja, Padmaja and Dr. Sri-kanya who supported me in my journey.

What triggered you to start an NGO?

I have one deaf and dumb older sister. I used to see her problems from my childhood. The need for services to such differently abled people was seeded somewhere in mind. Due to some mishaps in my personal life, my hidden desire to serve and educate the disabled children triggered me to acquire necessary employable skills. Then I had been to JSS where the skills are imparted at no cost. After gaining the necessary skills, I started giving training to disabled students in a rented house. This first step led to the start an NGO named Prajwal Vani Welfare Society (PVWS) in 2009, and its journey eventually got registered as a society under the Societies Act. GVMC allotted a permanent government building to run my NGO. I am offering training at no cost to the disabled children, from basics to employable skills.

Our PVWS society is providing vocational training to the various categories of differently abled [Hearing Impaired (HI), Visually Impaired (VI), Physically Challenged (OH) and also Special children (Mentally Challenged)]. The training courses include computer software, hardware, networking, 3D and Web designing. The courses like tailoring and jute bags making, silk, jewelry making, art craft, candles making and many incomes generated programs (IGP) are aimed for ladies.

So far, I trained 1600 students, and around 1250 of them got jobs. Such employed old students are now helping the other students too. Around 120 students in our community got training and placement as well. As its founder President, there are no boundaries for my happiness.

We came to know that you have awards and recognitions. Can we know from you?

I received many awards and a doctorate. To quote a few, Adarsha Vanitha Award by Bharata



Muni Arts Academy of Madanapalli, AP; Master Trainer in Sports Certificate from Lakshmi Bai National Institute of Physical Education, Gwalior; Junior Chambers International Award for Outstanding Silent Social Service; Savithri bhai Phule Award; Best NGO Award on the occasion of World Differently Abled Day, 3rd December in 2017; and a doctorate from Harvest Bible University.

The first one was founded in **Kharagpur, West Bengal** (then in Bengal Presidency) in the year 1920, primarily for the welfare of members employed in Bengal Nagpur Railway Co. Ltd., thereat and their families. Later, members from Kalinga Andhra viz., Berhampur in Ganjam Dist and Kotabommali came together to establish **All India Sistakaranam Association (AISKA)** after due deliberations during 1923-25 and finally in Jalumuru (now Srikakulam Dist AP) on May 30, 1925. It was registered in Berhampur, Orissa in 1947 with Regn No. 2/47 and re-registered in Visakhapatnam, AP with a new no. 117/1988.

Third **Andhra Pradesh Sistakaranam Association (APSKA)** was formed in Hyderabad with Regn No. 88/1965 (renamed as Telangana State Sistakaranam Assn. in 2014).

Today, we are distributed in about 16 States in India and have more than 50 Associations, Sanghams, etc. A quick head count reveals that about 37 Associations are listed in Andhra Pradesh, followed by West Bengal (1), Chhattisgarh (3), Odisha (6), Telangana (3), Jharkhand (1), Maharashtra (1) and New Delhi (1). Of course, Sistakaranams are also living in other States like Assam (NE), Punjab, Himachal Pradesh, MP, UP, Gujarat, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and in more than 10 countries abroad like USA, UK, Canada, Europe, UAE, Singapore, Australia, etc.

It is not very clear whether some of these Associations are formally constituted in compliance with respective State Societies Act(s), follow a set of registered Byelaws or Memorandum / Articles of Association, maintain proper Bank Accounts, maintain List of Members, collect any regular membership fee, conduct regular meetings including AGMs with Audited Accounts / Annual Reports and submit to the Registrars and renew their registrations, besides conducting Election of Office-bearers at periodic intervals. Ideally, if these regulatory compliances are done and activities or data of all the Associations are captured at an Apex level and consolidated, the community would be a formal, strong and recognized national body for all negotiations (like OBCs) with the government. Association Leadership should be not only accountable for all financial and non-financial activities, observe self-regulation and be transparent to submit Annual Reports to

the community they lead.

In addition to above Associations, we have Societies or bodies like Sistakaranam Ikya Vedika, Helping Hands, Lifting Hands, Yuvatha, Foundations, Welfare and Development Corporation, NGOs, Charitable Trusts and other groups for literary, cultural activities too. A few professionals also render social service like blood donations, legal services, marriage counseling, soft skills training or coaching for competitive exams like IIT or IAS through YouTube. Social Media platforms like Facebook and WhatsApp are being extensively used now. Most of the individuals may be having Facebook pages for fun and social interactions with friends, relatives, colleagues and their fraternity. Social Groups are prominent and very dominant in today's ICT (Information, Communication and Technology) and VUCA world. Mass Communications and Dissemination of informal messages, photos, announcements are happening at jet speed today, thanks to Facebook, WhatsApp, Twitter, Instagram, Blogs and others. If only the formal Community Associations could streamline all these activities and leverage on Technology! Interestingly, we have more than 20 Facebook pages for Sistakaranam Groups with a variety of names and all these are stand alone, not supervised well and inter-connected for benefit of the community. Similarly, the current trend is to open and use WhatsApp Groups by anyone and everyone, which is also followed by individuals and associations of Sistakaranams for a variety of purposes like Associations, EC Members, Activity oriented like Social Work, Literature, Culture, Politics, Employment, Matrimony, NRIs, Meetings, Celebrations and so on and on.

By and large, our Welfare Associations or Samitis or Sanghams are all engaged in social and cultural activities, primarily in their respective geographical areas on a limited scale. Mostly members of our Associations meet regularly for festivals like Sankranti, Ugadi, Ganesha Utsav, Dasara etc., and conduct religious rituals and cultural or sports events, literary activities for members / families. One common and conspicuous annual activity invariably held is **Karthika Vana Bhojanalu**, where pleasantries are exchanged. Felicitating meritorious or financing of poor students as also holding of Vivaha Parichaya Vedikas (matrimonial) are among the other major welfare activities most of our associations engage in. Absence of adequate finances and systematic planning is very conspicuous.

Hypothetically, a well-structured formal organization like Welfare Association would spell out its Objectives and conduct itself abiding

by the set of Rules, Byelaws or as in MOA and AOA. It is necessary that AISKA should be an umbrella organization for all Sistakaranams overseeing the running of Associations at different National / State / District / Mandal levels. To facilitate our Sistakaranam Welfare Associations function professionally and efficiently, it is suggested that they follow a Four Pillar Approach.

These are 1. Education 2. Employment 3. Matrimony and 4. Welfare Activities. With a clear set of guidelines, the elected Office-bearers could extend best of their services in helping our young members in all their educational pursuits, choose employment of their expertise, get married at right stage of their life and undergo the later stages to live happily.

1. Education: While funding the poor students and felicitating meritorious students say at SSC and HSC levels by some Associations is going on sporadically, such an intervention would help motivating our community in laying strong foundation right from the childhood itself. The next stage of college education for a child is very crucial. Today, our new generation have multiple avenues in choosing their line of study, but they need proper coaching, timely guidance and counseling. A lot depends on the individual child's intellect, family background, family size, place of living like rural or urban centre which will facilitate choosing a right course / College or career for life. One should know which Competitive / Entrance Exam to appear for and various steps involved in preparing / succeeding in the same. It may be for admission in ITIs, Polytechnics, IITs, NITs, IIITs, NDA, Architecture, Medicine / Engineering / Agriculture / Veterinary / Pharmacy with different branches, Arts / Science / Commerce / Management / Law / Education Degrees, Fine Arts like Music, Painting, Dance or Fashion Designing and so on. Those who want to study abroad or pursue Research / PhD may have to draw their short- and long-term plans both in academics, finances and career after mentor-

ing by Experts. It is also essential that some of our students may also require financial support / bank loans and documents evidencing BC or OBC to take advantage of the concessions from the government.

2. Employment: No doubt, unemployment problem is the biggest challenge in our country. When a student or eligible young individual is seeking employment, he or she needs clear direction. Our fraternity association members with their experience and expertise could arrange for counseling, coaching and show them the clear path. Not only these job-seekers will be looking for public sector or government jobs, but also in private sector including self-employment. Association Leaders who may also be Entrepreneurs or Professionals can guide the young men and women to look for new prospects including obtaining bank loans, subsidies, etc. No wonder, today the Sistakaranam community is listed as BC-D Category caste by the two Telugu States and all the Association Leaders at various levels are striving hard to get the community listed in OBC by the Central Government so that Education and Employment opportunities will brighten to the deserving candidates.

3. Matrimony: In the fast-changing modern world, our youth are getting drifted. Once they complete education and enter in decent jobs, they are unable to balance the present with

their own past. Exposure to Urban life is affecting they way of thinking towards life. Parents some times are becoming helpless in influencing or deciding in the matrimonial matters. This is resulting in delayed marriages, live in relationships, inter-caste / inter-religion marriages, broken marriages and remarriages have become the order of the day. All this, in spite of mediation by close relatives, well-wishers or family friends, marriage agents, Whatsapp groups, Vivaha Vedikas by many associations like in Visakhapatnam, Vizianagaram, Bhubaneswar, Hyderabad, Raipur, Rajahmundry, etc., host of matrimony websites like Shaadi.com, Bharat Matrimony, Patnaik Matrimony, Telugu Matrimony, Bandhan Matrimony, Matchfinder.in, Kalyan Matrimony, etc., websites of Sistakaranam Welfare Association, Sistakaranam Ikya Vedika and their LEKHA monthly digital magazine. Associations can play a vital role by efficient data management and guidance both to parents and youngsters. Presently, we have WhatsApp groups titled AISKAA Marriage Bureau, Subhamastu Kalyanamastu, Sistakaranalu Vivaha Parichaya Vedika Telangana and Sistakaranam Vivaha Vedika Swayamvaram

4. Welfare Activities: This is an open area. It could be a combination of planned activities and combating of emergencies or crises in many unfortunate lives. It is not enough if our Associations or Leaders work hard and get the

Status of B C at State level and OBC at Central Level for our community by putting in all out efforts and resources. They should ensure that right benefits are being derived by the deserving candidates in education, employment and careers. Through timely intervention, the ills in the matrimonial area are also to be prevented if not cured at a large scale. And then, there may be cases of accidents, mishaps, calamities and health problems or business failures if not job losses in some unfortunate cases of Sistakaranam families. Such unforeseen disasters are to be handled by the Associations by extending timely support and help, including by providing financial assistance to some on merits. Community development activities like laying of village roads, providing of drinking water facilities, Communications and Transportation, construction of Schools / Hospitals / Marriage Halls / Bus Shelters / Veterinary Hospitals with the support of funds from MLAs or MPs are to be arranged.

Learning from the experiences under different circumstances and diverse leadership over the years during the past one hundred years of our Sistakaranam associations, it is advisable that all our units would follow uniform systems and practices as suggested above to work for the overall benefit of the Sistakaranam community all over the world.

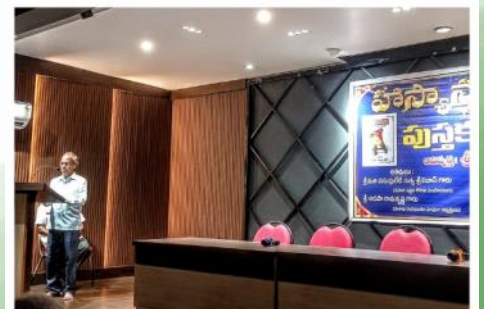

Borubhadra Head Master

He was a teacher. A statue for him. A guide to the community. His contribution to students development is invaluable.

He is Late Manipatruni Narasimha Murthy Master Garu (still known as Borubhadra Head Master Garu in Borubhadra neighborhood). He came from a middle class family and worked tirelessly for Zilla Parishad High School in Borubhadra, touching of the feet of several political leaders, and finally achieved success and became the founder and first Head Master of the school. As the recipient of the State Government's Uttama Upadhyaya Award, he became the talk of the town in the remote Borubhadra village of Srikakulam district.



Unable to bear his death in 2002, his children, village elders, students who studied under him, came up with the idea of erecting a statue in his honor on August 15, 2024 this year, the day of India's Independence. The Day has come to fulfill their wish to install a

statue in the premises of the Zilla Parishad High School which he established.

Our relatives, well-wishers, students, fans are invited by the family members and village people. We must know about him, his efforts are limitless. To make the weak students talented. This success has inspired many people. In this way, all the successes can be said to be wonderful days in his life. In Srikakulam district, the lion's share of public sector officials, best citizens, political leaders and people of repute have studied under them. I also studied with him in high school. I pay homage to our teacher on this occasion. Apart from this, it should be recalled on this occasion that he also took responsibility and played a vital role in the construction of a primary hospital, Borubhadra High School, construction of a bridge between Garebilli gadda between Borubhadra & Kotabommali RS, bus facility from Borubhadra to Meghvaram, and many such community development activities. He used to say that everyone is responsible for the progress of the country. This great man has one son and six daughters. His youngest daughter was our classmate. We studied together. They are all leading progressive lives with their families. National BC Association Secretary, Syndicate Member JNTU, Vizianagaram Dr. Budumuru Rajesh, who is well known in community is his grandson.

Late Manipatruni Narsimha Murthy was born 06.09.1931, and died on 16.04.2002.

Dr Ippili Sankara Rao was born in Saluru, Srikakulam (now Vizianagaram) Dist on June 1, 1958 to Sri Ippili Apparao (Sub-Inspector of Police, AP) and Smt Sarojini, house-wife. Dr Rao had his early education in Visakhapatnam, Srikakulam, Kaviti and Ichapuram. He studied B.Sc in Bobbili and later completed M.Sc. and Ph.D. in Nuclear Chemistry from Andhra University, Visakhapatnam in 1987. Dr Rao received his PhD in Nuclear Chemistry from Andhra University, Vizag in 1987 from the hands of Smt Kumud Ben Joshi, then Governor of AP.

Dr Rao began his professional career with a brief stint in NSTL, Visakhapatnam and later as a Junior College Lecturer in Paderu. He was elevated as Principal of Junior Colleges in Polaki and Narasannapeta from where he retired in the year 2018. He received an award as Best Principal at Polaki Govt Junior College during the year 2009-2010. Government of AP also felicitated him on the Republic Day in 2013 for his contribution to Vocational Education (Intermediate Studies) as Principal of Govt Junior College, Polaki.



On November 18, 2018, Sishtakaranam Sangham of Narasannapeta felicitated him on his retirement listing out milestones of his career and life as also his exceptional personality traits of kindness towards his students and community for generating employment opportunities.

- The ultimate goal of human human life is not merely to accumulate wealth. He explained using it to make life happy, for one to find ways to make one's life happy with money, what to do and how to do it, and what not to do.

- When we decide to do any work, the first doubt that we feel is, "Can I do that work?" in our mind. What is needed to clear this doubt is self-belief that we can do this work. How to create the environment for this self-confidence? He explained that in detail.

- He also mentioned creative way of thinking.

- It is the leader who drives human society forward, what are the qualities of such a leader? And what are the qualities required to have a great personality? Vidura explained the details in detail.

Sidhis

In Spiritual Journey sadhaks tend to gain paranormal abilities, or experience paranormal phenomena. These may be considered as the start of a person's self realization or spiritual journey. Usually it takes certain deeper practise for one to attain a silent mind. As the mind becomes silent, and the sadhaks are closely associated with Gurus, sadhaks start experiencing sensations and so forth. These can develop into a well recognized siddhi in the spiritual realm. Not every phenomenon may be termed as

Siddhi but they are akin to a Siddhi. In other words they are super natural, and not a common experience.

Attaining silent mind itself is a siddhi, and ofcourse there is a degree to which one can silence the mind. A more common thing is heightened abilities, such as ability to imagine, ability to guess and ability to comprehend, ability to live life with ease, and so forth. This can be marked as real start of spiritual journey, or we can call that, one is self-realizing at this stage. From there it may take a life time or few births to liberation. The paranormal phenomenon or sidhi, helps as a guide, for the person to continue his or her journey towards self realization.

Some other siddhis are telepathy, clairvoyance, astral travel, clear visions, third-eye opening, manifesting what is imagined,

kundalini awakening, pausing the breath (Kumbhakam). These need not be taken as the person have realized. The journey continues. A guru is one who can invoke these into others. For example reading whether ones chakras are opened

(scanning), opening others third-eye, doing shaktipat, or awakening others kundalini, are all extraordinary siddhis, that Gurus possess. There are many possible sidhis like these. Gurus can tell future and so forth. read others mind, and so forth. Masters are known to be exhibiting miracles. These supernatural phenomenon are true, and one can trust them only when one has direct experience of it. Until, then one can only believe them, but not necessarily know that it is possible. The Kundalini (Para kundalini) awakening is known to bring many siddhis to the realizing person.

The best for the realizing person is to not to carry away with the siddhis, and continue to probe inside, and keep seeking the soul inside. The siddhis can indirectly help one to walk towards liberation.

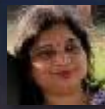

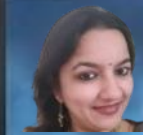

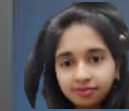
