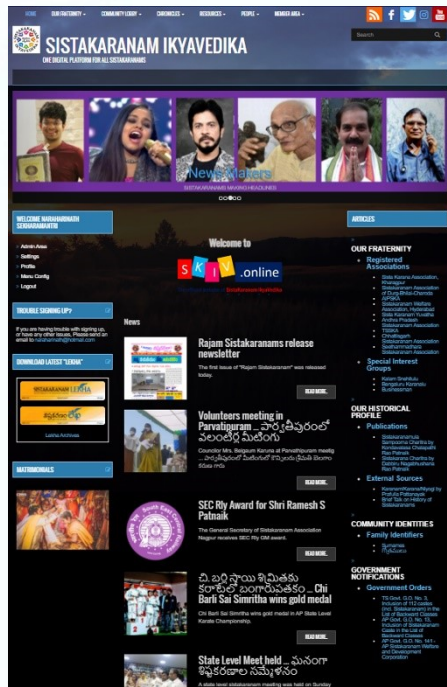

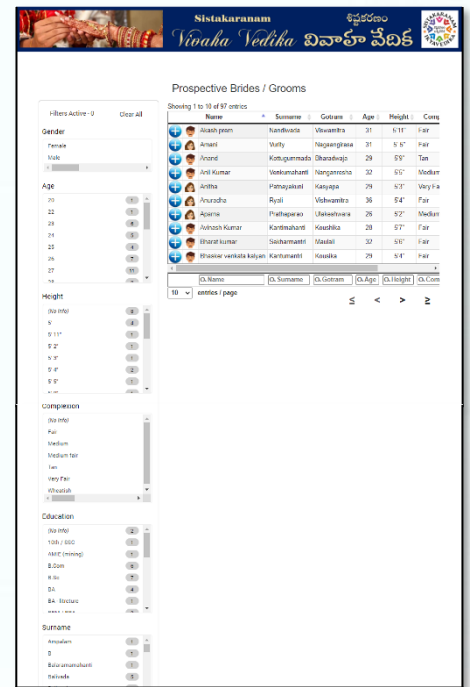

tory requirements, once the same is clear.

As for the content in the newsletter, including advertisements, it is all sourced either through contributions from members of the community, or from resources that are in the public domain, including news media and social media (such as Facebook & WhatsApp), without any financial consideration to anyone. "Mother India" award to Rajeti Ganapati Rao

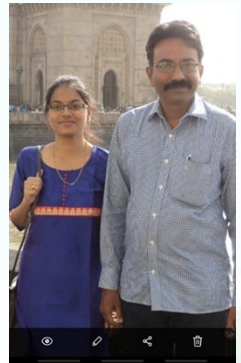

Self-Confidence

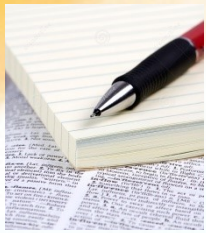
Namaskaram to all relatives.

Godhan Nyay Yojana – A First of a Kind Scheme in India

The government of Chhattisgarh launched 'Godhan Nyay Yojana' in the state on June 25, 2020. The scheme aims to make animal husbandry commercially profitable, prevent open grazing by cattle, and solve the problem of stray animals on roads and for environmental conservation. The Godhan Nyay Yojana is expected to be an innovative step forward towards protecting the financial interest of livestock owners in the state. The scheme is expected to boost the efforts made by the state government to strengthen the rural economy.

Under this scheme, the Chhattisgarh government will procure cow dung from livestock owners at a fixed procurement rate. The procurement rate of the cow dung under Godhan Nyay Yojana is decided and regularly monitored by a five-member sub-committee of the Cabinet chaired by the Agriculture and Water Resource Minister. The procurement rate of cow dung is usually fixed after deliberating upon the suggestions received from the livestock owners, farmers, cowshed operators, and other experts.

The Godhan Nyay Yojana has been launched to fix the problem of strays and to benefit the farmers and cattle owners. Chhattisgarh has a tradition of cattle grazing in open, which harms the cattle as well as the crops of farmers. Besides this, stray animals on roads in cities are the major cause of road accidents. The cow-owners often leave their cows astray after milking, which causes various problems.

The procured cow dung will be utilized for the production of vermicompost fertilizer, which will then be sold through cooperative societies to meet the fertilizer requirement of the farmers as well as that of the Agriculture, Forest, Horticulture, and Urban Administration Department for various plantation campaigns. With this initiative, Chhattisgarh has become the first state in India to procure cow dung for the welfare of livestock owners.

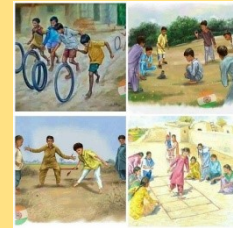
The days leading to the event were marked by the release of teasers periodically, that triggered interest in the members and ensured participation in large numbers.

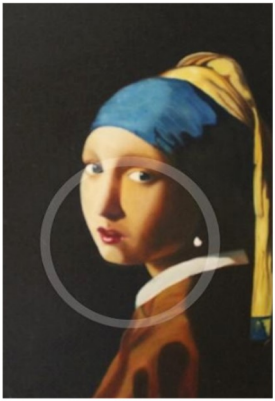

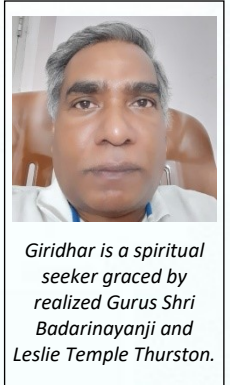
While a Bhakta assumes a form and does Puja to that form a Jnani seeks to understand the inner workings of consciousness.
