It is a matter of pride that our Sistakaranam senior leader Sri. **D. V. Krishna Rao** delivered a fine speech on this

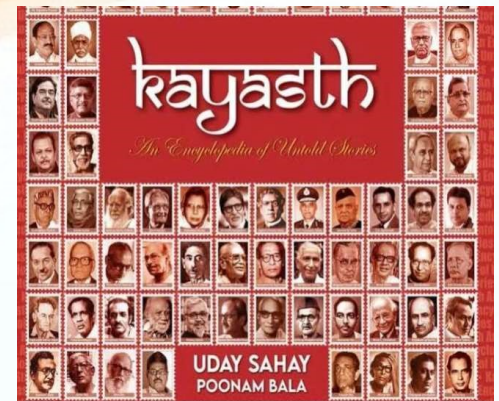
big platform. Our community senior stalwart, a good motivator for youth leaders, a very service oriented person,

The Union government on Thursday moved the Supreme Court for a reconsideration of its May 5 judgment, which ruled that after a constitutional amendment in 2018, state governments have no power to draw up their own lists of backward classes.

In its review petition, the Centre has contended that the judgment required a relook because there were errors apparent on the face of the record.

E-Commerce App Launched

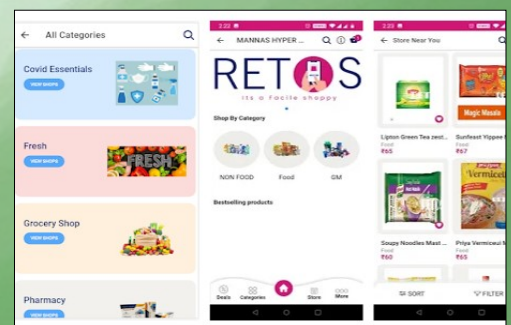

Murthy, who is the publicity secretary for SWA, had his poem selected as the best poem in the online poetry event conducted

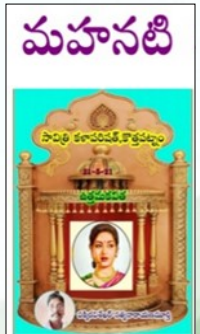
by Savitri Kalaparishath Kottapatnam.

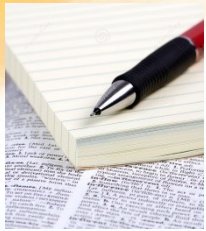
We, And Our Thoughts

Omnipresent with multi-skills

A person known to all of us for his zeal to do service for progression of Sistakaranams and talent search and its utilization. He talks to us and guides in almost all WhatsApp groups. He is none other than Sadasivuni Lakshmana Rao, a much-sought personality by our groups. Lekha is privileged to interview him.

Tell us about your parents and your childhood

My father, Late Shri Sadasivuni Koteswara Rao was a Teacher and my mother, Smt. Sadasivuni (Dabbiru) Bhanumati is a housewife. We are two brothers and two sisters.

Are you Agriculturalist by education? Tell us about your studies.

My childhood studies were almost in the villages of Srikakulam district. I did my Intermediate in Tekkali. After that, I did B.Sc. (Agriculture) from reputed agricultural college, Bapatla, the then Andhra Pradesh Agricultural University. I got 3rd rank. I got selected for Officer post in Indian Bank in the year 1984.

What is your upscaling in Indian Bank?

I passed CAIIB, an in-house professional examination for further promotions in the banking sector. I worked in various capacities as Branch Manager, Officer-in-Charge of Rural Development Centre, Lead District Manager of Krishna District, Head of the Retail Banking Segment, Second-in-Command as Deputy Zonal Manager for Chittoor Zone. Lastly, I worked as Branch Manager, Secunderabad. I took VRS ahead of 6 years' service for retirement due to my health problems. I was always in the Executive Body of Indian Bank Officers Association of AP Unit. I got many award and rewards in my service. I attribute my success in life to my beloved mother in particular and my father in general. I am indebted to our entire ancestor Gurus who provided me with treasure of knowledge.

Would you please share with our Lekha readers about your contributions to our Community?

The group got instant success and today has around 260 businessmen in the group. As one of the Admins of Kalam Snehitulu, an exclusive literary WhatsApp group, I have compiled four Kavita Sankalanams on Mother's Day, Simhachalam etc. I am fond of writing poetry, short stories in Telugu and cartooning also. I won top prize in a state level cartooning competition in 1983 and since then 2000 cartoons were published. Similarly, I have compiled and brought a book "All India Telugu Cartoonists Directory 2021" which got appreciation from all.

Any message to our community?

Always keep in mind that whenever a Sistakaranam comes to you for help, extend possible help or guide him properly till he gets help. Infighting among us deprived the benefits of BC from 1970 to 2009. We all must be united in achieving common goals. I appreciate Lekha team members for disseminating community information and motivating all of us.

Lakshman Rao is a content man with what he has in his hand and focus on service. He never aspired for GM position in his job even though he had the chance. Manyam Babu Rao gives Essentials to the poor

International Human Rights educator and National Award recipient Manyam Baburao has expressed concern that the poor are starving as they lose their jobs during the second wave of the corona epidemic. On Saturday, in Kancharpalem, low lying area, essential services was extended to the poor. Two minutes mourning was observed for the lives that were lost due to the Covid pandemic. Allena Mahaveer Bharat Kumar, who was present in this program said, unlike any other times, we have lost many lives and some became orphans. It was a part of service program where he mentioned, about the need to support the unorganized workers and the poor. He said journalists, who are the bridge between



government and the people, have been dying, and demanded support for the corona affected people. Allena Bharat Kumar, who attended the event, criticized private hospitals which were robbing the common man and asked the government officials to constantly monitor every private hospital.

Kirti Patnaik's Services during Lockdown

Kirti Patnaik, head of the Sridevi Vignana Jyoti Purashkar Charitable Trust, continued her services even during the corona lockdown. Free treatment and counseling online for pregnant women with corona infection, helping to provide negative plasma to a pregnant patient named Aruna, Bringing to the attention of the authorities difficulty in finding oxygen, beds and arranging the same for corona patients, were some of the services provided.

Providing details to patients who do not know where Remdesivir injections are available, sending doctors home for corona testing & treatment, giving Encouragement to patients in home isolation, assisting in distribution of meals to those in need, bringing to the notice of Zonal Commissioner Simhachalam some patients who were having difficulty knowing where to get the second dose of the vaccine, assisting in their



vaccination, were taken up by Kirti Patnaik, Head of Sridevi Vignana Jyothi Purashkar Charitable Trust, who is serving in Visakhapatnam in her own style during the difficult times of Corona. Also, her valuable suggestion to help Sistakaranam relatives in need of quarantine, by requesting community elders through Whatsapp group to convert community halls, that are lying unused due to lack of meetings, into quarantine facilities was very well received.

Guruprasad felicitated for Service to People

Sompeta Tehsildar, Guruprasad has been at the forefront of resolving any issues.

Once, to help a sick person, since the ambulance driver was not there, he himself drove the ambulance wearing a PP kit. Another time, when traffic was stuck in Sompeta, he took up the police role and organised the traffic. Once he visited a school and taught lessons to the students. Once a woman died of Covid and no one went



near her. Immediately on receiving the information, the Tehsildar arranged for the 'Swargadhamam Radham', and placed the

body in the vehicle. He even intervenes in rural development even while going to address revenue problems in villages.

Sompeta Senior Civil Judge Koteswara Rao recently honored the services rendered by the Tehsildar. Guruprasad says that even the Collector, Niwas and Joint Collectors are always trying to get rid of the notion of being government employees and be recognized as public servants.

Mandala Vikalangula Samkshema Sangam - For the Disabled, By the Disabled

The organization is the vision of Mr. P. S. T. Patnaik who is himself a disabled from childhood because of polio. He has to spend most of his time in the wheelchair. As he already gone through the trauma and difficulties faced by the persons with disabilities, he wanted to help other persons like him. As he was educated upto matriculation he knew about some government schemes, so he initially started to help disabled persons living in Atchuthapuram mandal. Later, with the help of some of his friends he started working in the rural mandals of Rambilli, Mungapaka, Madagula, Parawada along with Atchuthapuram. After some time, he formed the organization and got it registered in 1994 under the society act of XXI/1860 and named it Mandala Vikalangula Samkshema

Sangham with its administrative and registered office located at Atchuthapuram, 50 km from Visakhapatnam. Mr. P. S. T. Patnaik was elected the founder Secretary of the organization, so the organization came to be known as "organization for the disabled run by the disabled". presenting our caste, our pen, our voice as single family of literature lovers.

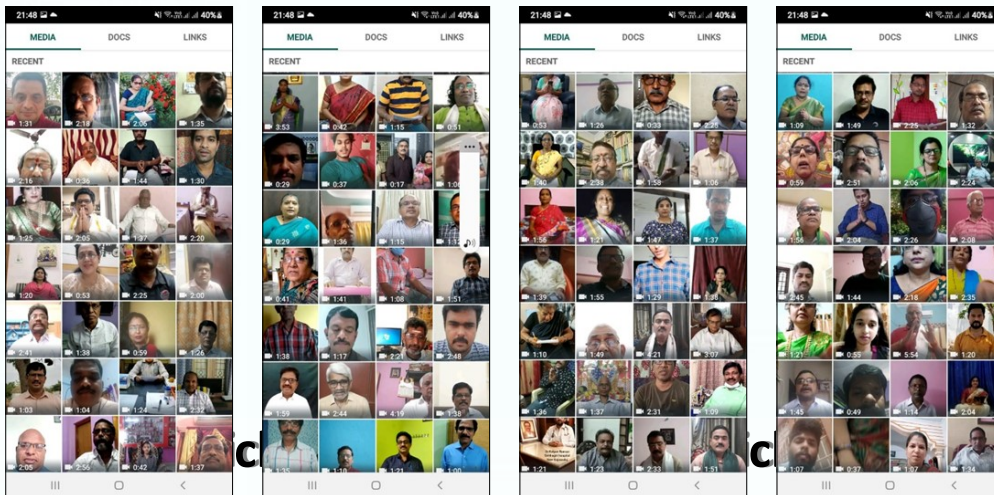

Know about Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs)

MSME covers only manufacturing and service industries. Trading companies are not covered by the scheme. MSME is to support start-ups with subsidies and benefits. Registration of firm under MSME is open to proprietorship, Hindu undivided family, association of persons, co-operative society, partnership firm, company or undertaking etc.

MICRO
Investment in Plant and Machinery or Equipment: Not more than Rs.1 crore and Annual Turnover; not more than Rs. 5 crores
SMALL
Investment in Plant and Machinery or Equipment: Not more than Rs.10 crore and Annual Turnover; not more than Rs. 50 crores
MEDIUM
Investment in Plant and Machinery or Equipment: Not more than Rs.50 crore and Annual Turnover; not more than Rs. 250 crores

Any individual, say as proprietor can now register his/her firm online on Udyam Portal as MSME by giving details of PAN card/Aadhar. Aadhar and PAN are mandatory. While registering online, OTP is sent to the mobile registered with Aadhar card. An enterprise whose turnover is above the threshold limit of Rs.40 lakh needs to register under GST first and then as MSME. There is no registration fee. Priority is given for industrialization of rural and backward areas. Hence, the MSMEs include skilled craftsmen, artisans and enterprises in the informal sector/unorganised sector.

Benefits of MSME Registration

The MSME Development Act, 2006 governs various benefits enumerated under the Act.

Collateral-free loan facilities & Priority lending:

Specified banks and NBFCs shall provide collateral-free loans amounting to 20% of outstanding credit. Similarly, loans are also provided that can be infused as equity.

Credit Linked Capital Subsidies for MSMEs:

CLCS is a choice for techno-based MSMEs to upgrade their obsolete technologies so as to sustain in the market. There is also a ceiling in 15% capital subsidy which is 15 Lakh for induction of well-established and improved technology. One has to refer the list of sectors and products identified by MSME Ministry.



Credit Linked Guarantee Scheme:

SIDBI have established a Trust named Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE) specifically to implement Credit Guarantee Fund Scheme for micro and small enterprises. This scheme allows collateral-free loans of up to 50 lakhs for individual MSMEs.

Low interest rate of loan:

Businesses or enterprises after obtaining MSME registration certificate can avail a benefit of 1% on the Overdraft loan and GST-registered MSME can get 2% interest subvention. It is available for incremental loans of Rs 1 crores under the MSME Credit Scheme.

ISO certification Charges Reimbursement:

There has been given relaxations to MSMEs from all expenses incurred for obtaining ISO 9000, ISO 14001, and HACCP (Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point) certifications.

Incubation Scheme For MSME:

The incubation scheme provides opportunity to the innovators in developing their new innovative ideas for the creation of new innovative products. Nature of assistance are as follows:

- Under this scheme financial assistance up to 15 lakhs is provided for developing and nurturing of an idea.
- Financial assistance up to 1.00 Cr. is provided for procurement and installation of Plant and Machines in (Business Incubator) BI. This will strengthen the technology-related R&D activities of BI.
- Financial assistance of up to 1.00 Cr. provided as grants in aid for the seed capital support to (Host Institutions) HIs/BIs for promoting them to converting their ideas into start-ups.

Who can apply: Student/Entrepreneurs of the Institute such as Technical colleges, Universities, other professional colleges/institutes, R&D institutes, NGOs involved in relevant activities, EDCs of O/o DC (MSME), MSME-DIs/Technology Centers (TCs), DICs or any Institute/Organization of Central/State Govt.

Market Development Assistance Scheme for MSME:

Under this scheme, The Central Government follows a Price and Purchase Preference policy wherein around 358 items are listed for exclusive purchases by Central Government from the MSME units only. They are numerous supports like marketing assistance even for those products, which are manufactured by MSMEs and do not fall under the purview of Reservation Policy. Apart from this MSMEs are encouraged to register with Government e-Market (GeM) web portal maintained by Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. Government organizations can directly place purchase orders without any purchase procedure with the firms registered with GeM. There are instructions to government organizations and public sector to buy certain percentage of purchase budget directly from MSME organizations registered with GeM.

Subsidy on Patent Registration:

More than 50% subsidy is given to the Enterprise that has the certificate of registration granted by MSME in fees for patent registration of MSMEs.

Protection against Delayed Payments:

At times, the buyers of services or products from the MSME's or Small Scale Industries tend to delay the payment. MSME ministry provided a helping hand to such enterprises by giving them the right to collect interest on the late payments from buyers. The settlement will be done through conciliation and arbitration and it will be resolved in minimum time.

100% tax exemption for Innovative start-ups:

No Income Tax required to be paid in 3 year out of 7 Years – ie. Start-ups are eligible for getting 100% tax exemption on profit for a period of three years in a block of seven years provided that annual turnover does not exceed Rs 25 crores in any financial year.

Concessions on Electricity Bills:

Govt has provided relief to registered MSMEs in electricity bills.

Adivishnu, Hasya Katha Nidhi (1939-2020)



Sri Adivishnu was a renowned Telugu Writer and 'Nandi Award' recipient who has introduced a unique sense of humour to Telugu people for six decades, owing to a subtle style of comedy. While his

first film 'Bala Mithrula Katha' was a message-oriented film, Adivishnu garu has written many comedy films like 'Sundari Subbarao', 'Ahana Pellanta' and 'Vivaha Bhojanambu'. He was born in 1939 to Lakshminarasamma and Nagayya as their fifth child. Although he was named 'Vigneshwara Rao', since he was born on the day of Vinayaka Chaviti, eventually he made his initial 'Adivishnu' as his 'Pen Name'.

He was honoured by the Title 'Hasya Nidhi' for his humorous writings. At this juncture, we take pride in the fact that Sri Adivishnu hailed from our community. Sri Adivishnu had started writing short stories during his school days and by 1959, while pursuing graduation from Bandar Hindu College, he made his debut as a director and as an actor in several plays organised by 'Parishads' and also won the Best Actor award for his performance in the play "Anantam".

In 1961, he wrote a story 'Aggi barata' in the Telugu magazine 'Andhra Patrika', which became the first story to be published in a popular weekly magazine. He then started writing novels with the publication of 'Toli Majili' in 'Bharati Masa Patrika' (1962) and later entered into the world of Drama by writing a play called 'Arakurani' (1963). He also made a name for himself as a playwright and screenwriter with the dramas such as 'Manchu Tera' (1964). Gradually he also contributed to films.

During his long writing career of over 60 years, he has written many stories, novels, plays and films. A few examples include: Stories, Plays & Dramas Such as: 'Udyogam', 'Sagatu Manishi', 'Collector Kshaminchu'; Novels such as 'Toli Mazilee', 'Manishi Midhya'; Dramas Such as 'Manchu Tera', 'Siddhartha' and Movies such as 'Aha Naa Pellanta and 'Vivaha Bhojanambu'. Some of the works have been translated into other languages like Hindi and Kannada and have impressed the readers there as well.

In the 1980's, for the first time, All India Radio had aired short stories (about 5 minutes long) named 'Chenukulu', written by Sri Adivishnu, which can be hailed as a successful experiment ahead of its time - around the commercial promotion of Products, in this case, 'Priya Pickles'.

Sri Adivishnu has the distinction of writing more than thousand satirical stories for a popular Telugu Daily Newspaper Publication - Eenadu, based on day-to-day real-life events with the title 'SariGamalu'. He also Contributed directly and indirectly to more than forty films.

Many of his works in almost all the major Telugu magazines have won awards and critical acclaim.

In 1984, he received the prestigious 'Nandi Award' for his contribution to the Film 'Sundari Subbarao'.

During the Silver Jubilee of his writing career in 1985, Dr.C. Narayana Reddy and Akkineni Nageswara Rao presented the title of 'Hasyanidhi'. At the 2000 Nandi Drama Festival, the play "Kalala Rajyam" won second best performance, as well as Best Comedian and Character Awards. The film 'Aha Naa Pellanta' written by him has created a new trend in the history of comedy films. After retiring as the CPRO in APSRTC in the joint state of Andhra Pradesh in 1998, Adivishnu worked for 'Ushakiran Movies' for a couple of years and



for 'Prajasakti Daily' for another four years.

It was incidental that, the character of Ganesha in our mythology triggers humour and in real life, Vigneshwara Rao alias Adivishnu, who can be compared with Ganesha - lived true to his name by making the readers enjoy through his humorous writings.

On January 6, 2020, the day of 'Vaikuntha Ekadashi', he left to the heavenly abode and reached the eternal blessings of his beloved Lord Sri Venkateswara Swamy.

"Nataraju" Kuppili Venkateswara Rao

When his name is mentioned, the world of theater still gets thrilled. Monarch of the theatre, the late Sri Kuppili Venkateswara Rao, who had been a sensation in telugu theater for nearly three decades, made hundreds of actors, led life as a drama and drama as his life, was born on 20 November 1923 in an abandoned train coach lying in the yard at a railway station in Chagallu village of West Godavari district.

Mrs. Sitayamma and Sri Kuppili Prakashrao are his birth parents. The disease 'Asthma' subjugated him and he suffered throughout his life. His Childhood passed barely able to speak due to illness. By the time he learned to speak, he was eight.

His father was a modest employee in railways. After completing high school studies, he could not complete intermediate at Rajahmundry Government Arts College due to family financial conditions. In 1945, he joined the 'Srikalahasti' station in the Southern Railway. In the same year, Venkateswara Rao was married to Shardamma. In 1946, was transferred to Bezwada railway division and stayed there until 1960. While in Madras, he was favored by famous directors and producers B.N. Reddy and Chakrapani. It was B.N. Reddy who advised K.V. Gopala Swamy Naidu to take Venkateswara Rao as stage director at the University Department of Theatre Arts. Thus, in 1961, Visakhapatnam Andhra University appointed him as the first study director of the 'Theatre of Arts'.

Venkateswara Rao, who said "drama is my breath, life is next" was forced to share half of his breath to Asthma, but with the other half, with twice the persistence, he pushed the disease down, pushed the people who would be happy if he fell down, went on the run, and lit up the Telugu theatre with innovative flames. He was popularly referred as 'Nataraju' by the people.

Venkateswara Rao's 'acting' was in his blood. When he was ten or eleven years old, he earned everyone's appreciation by imitating the gestures of a beggar. Venkateswara Rao was recognized as an actor and promoted by Sri Pingali Venkataramaiah, a physics lecturer at Rajahmundry Arts College, by offering the role of Papayasastry in his 1945 'Karanikam'. Venkateswara Rao received the first prize for best performance in his first play.

After settling in a railway job in Vijayawada in 1948, he dedicated his heart and soul to theater. He performed in many dramas and plays. Many more prizes and titles were won. Not satisfied with them, he directed plays, and created unprecedented new trends in acting and performance. Rehearsing the play tightly. fully understanding the role to be played, examining the character from the point of view of self-criticism, starting the play on time... most of all, giving discipline the first place among everything... has brought Venkateswara Rao to his peak level.

Starting with the 'Navya Kalamandal' drama society in 1948, Sri Muthukrishna's 'Storm in a Tea Cup' was performed several times. Mrs. Nirmala, who was the heroine in it, went on to become a well-known film actress. In 1951, in Vijayawada, the RaSana Federation (Federation of Rasanas, Sahridayas and Actors) was established, roaming the country, performing and giving a status and respect to social drama. Later, the federal branches of The RaSana. extended to Kakinada (1959), Madras (1960) and Visakhapatnam (1961).

Whatever the role... it was as if Venkateswara Rao would transmigrate into the role bring it alive in front of the audience. He played the role of Srinivasam in the drama 'Na Babu' and gave a good interpretation of the association of 'Father and Son'. It was only after seeing this drama that Mr. D.V. Subba Rao praised him with the title 'Nataraju'. In Prakhya Sriramamurthy's play 'Phani'... Venkateswara Rao proved that none was his equal in acting. The fame earned for the play 'Ragaragini' was of the highest level. Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan himself praised the play as a exceptional.

The role of father in the play 'Nababu', the role of a soldier Amarayya in the play Vishwashanti, the role of a school teacher in Maa Ooru, the role of Girisham in Kanyashulkam, the role of Murari in Kirtiseshulu, the role of Peddaiah in the play Koduku Puttala... Like this... Venkateswara Rao has played many, many different roles and has provided a new definition of acting.

Venkateswara Rao, who makes one wonder was he born for the role of 'Rama Brahmam' in the play 'Donga Veerudu', ' who played loyal servant in 'Kappalu', won the 'Best Actor' award even donning such a small role. Venkateswara Rao, who weapon is usually dialogue delivery in plays, has shown how silence, looks and expression can be made into many dialogues by the role of 'Raghu' in the play 'Ragaragini' written by Sri Gollapudi Maruthi Rao.

He would make his plays with the aim of bringing new and new concepts to the theater. 'Beththam Manishi' – a speechless Drama, Kanyasulkam – a drama shortened to 2 1/2 hrs, Mahanatudu – a Subjective Drama Performance...

This is how the stage became his laboratory. His dedication to the theater is unwavering. When his ten-month-old son (first born) died... when everyone was in mourning, he told the Akashvani (Vijayawada) center that he'll be there in half an hour, a gave a live performance of Sri Korrapati Gangadhar Rao's 'Na Babu' drama. The son of the character he plays in that drama dies. Another time when Sri Raghava's 'Kanaka Pushyaram' is going to New Delhi for a drama show, the news of his sister's death, who he loved very much, arrives. After a few moments of grief, he boarded a train to reach New Delhi and gave a wonderful performed in the play.

Establishing The South Indian Actors Federation In 1958, and continuously working for its development, and large-scale responsible performances in the Indian capital New Delhi made Venkateswara Rao's efforts recognized by all at the national level. In New Delhi, the RaSana federation performed dramas and plays such as 'Akasharammana, Pelli Chooopulu, Guddilokam, Venkanna Kapuram, Ragaragini, Kappalu, Donga Veerudu, Kanakapushya Ragam, Triveni, Asura Sandhya etc.

His reputation as a judge in the Nataka Parishad is forever intact. He never compromised on giving the first mark to the mastery of the actors. He did not have any prejudice. That place is unique in the history of theater as the best quality talent discoverer.

Venkateswara Rao's innumerable radio plays and dramas were presented by Akashvani Vijayawada and Visakhapatnam centers. His important plays in Akashvani were 'Mudanthasthula Meda, Kirtiseshulu, Akharu Premalekha, Kanyashulkam, Ragaragini, Na Babu, O Sita Katha, Tamarapoovu Kanuka' etc.

The world of cinema also warmly welcomed the great man. His first film was 'Iddaru Mitruulu'. In 1960-61, he not only acted as the hero's father in the film 'Vagdanam', which was directed and produced by Atreya, but also worked as assistant directors for the film. His last film was 'Kanne Vayasu'. Those who were under his apprenticeship, and were to the film industry include Potti Prasad C. H. Krishnamurthy, Chatla Sriramulu, G.V. Subba Rao, Sakshi Ranga Rao, Krishna Chaitanya, Mishra, Dham. Tambu, Brinjala, Jayashree, Mrs. Vanibala, K. Vijayalakshmi, Pavala Shyamala etc.

The doctors who examined him in 1971 said that if he stopped plays he had ten years, and if he continued the plays he would live for two years. "What's the point of my subsistence if I don't make plays," he said and continued the plays. Three days after the historic honour of Sri Venkateswara Rao by Secunderabad Lalitha Kala Sanstha, on May 12, 1973, Nataraju, Rangasthala Natasamrat, Nata Chaturasana, Ranga Bhaskara title holder, breathed his last on May 15, 1973.

However, as long as the Telugu theater lives, 'Nataraju' Venkateswara Rao will live.

Baliwada Kanta Rao

Late Baliwada Kanta Rao (July 3, 1927 - May 6, 2000) was a well-known Telugu novelist. He was born in a village called Madapam in Srikakulam district of Andhra Pradesh. Served in various cadres in the Indian Army. Wrote up to 38 novels. He has written over 400 stories, 5 plays and radio plays and has never compromised on standards at any stage. His qualities of honesty, integrity, compassion, kindness, compassion, etc. are evident in his writings. He can speak not



only Telugu and English but also Bengali and Oriya. However, the most valuable attribute in Kantaravugari's storytelling is modesty. They leave to the reader what should not be revealed in the story and prepare the probability and relevance of what is revealed.

His book was published by the National Book Trust in all Indian languages. In 1972, the novel Punyabhoomi won the Andhra Pradesh Sahitya Akademi Award.

In 1986, the novel Vansadhara won the Telugu University Awards. Gopichand Award in 1988 in recognition of Kantarao's services in literature

Amarajivi Pulupula Venkatasivayya Sahitya Satkaram in 1993 by the Andhra Pradesh Abhyudaya Writers' Association, Guntur District Branch.

Kalasagar Madras Distinguished Award in 1996, Ravi Shastri Memorial Award

Baliwada Kantarao Kathalu a collection of short stories published by Vishalandhra Publishing House in 1998, won the Central Literary Academy Awards.

He has been honored on many occasions by various literary organizations. He has written three theoretical essays on the writings of Baliwada Kantaravu and obtained his Ph.D. Degrees, some earned MPL degrees

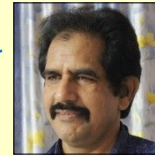
