## Meeting Notes

The meeting was organized with the purpose of providing a platform of expression for the Sista Karanam Yuva Sena group through Sista Karanam Iky Veda, Google Meet.

First, Mohan Patnaik invited elders and young people on behalf of Sista Karanam Yuva Sena and started the meeting. He said that yuva sena is a sena and that all are soldiers here but there will be no leaders, and we will follow the footsteps of our elders. Everyone has the right to speak here, if anyone misspeaks, we will correct it and any action will be done after due interaction with the concerned youth. He concluded the speech by hoping that Yuva Sena will be the right channel for youngsters inclined towards community activities.

Later, Santosh Kumar Behara said that it is a pleasure to start the Yuva Sena and it is a pleasure to see so many elders and the youth will go ahead with the elders' guidelines.

Later, Eluru Ramesh expressed his desire to go down the path set by the elders and serve the caste, saying that he was the youngest of all in Krishna district and that he was now moving towards caste.

Later, Karanam Edukondalu was introduced as from Krishnapatnam village in Muthukuru mandal of Nellore district and explained to the elders and young people that he was a Karanam caste member and that there were 300 families with him there.

Later, Karanam Niranjana Babu introduced himself from Chittoor and explained that he was also a Karanam caste member and explained their way of life and they felt happy to they were also included in the Yuva Sena.

Later, honorable Sri A.R.K. Rao, addressed the Yuva Sena and said that yuva sena is a good idea, the future is in your hands, the youth of the country should be united, all should come together and know the importance of caste and move forward. He said that, in the book that he is writing, he covered about the present conditions of our castes & gothrams, how the caste system is born from the varnas, and that while Brahmins are categorized as Vedics & Niyogis the youth should recognize that we are Sistakaranams.

Later, Sri Baliwada Satya Rao, in his usual style of addressing everyone with a poetic point of view, greeted with a good evening to all and gave guidelines to the youth with the slogan that all should be well we should be part of it. He explained the status of the caste in a poetic reference. He urged the youth to move forward and be an example to others.

After all the youth had spoken, our senior leader, inspiration to youth, noted orator, mentor, well-wisher, honborary Sri D.V. Krishna Rao, speaking about yuva sena, said they should move ahead with selfless service and ensure a better future tomorrow for the youth. He encouraged them to be as committed as in other castes. He said that activities should be conducted within proper guidelines, one should not for go after leadership, but leadership should come by itself. He said that the youth in the Telugu states should be organized, leadership should be respected by the leaders and the development of the Karanam Sistakaranam caste should be supported.

Shri B. R. M. Patro, who is always supporting the youth and providing regular assistance to the youth, said that like the Vanara Sena that supported Lord Sri Ram, this Yuva Sena should serve the Karanam and Sistakaranam caste. He also recalled that he was also a leader from the youth of our caste. The breaking of the joint family system, and our caste confined to three districts, should be addressed and we spread across with the help of youth. He said that after the existing leaders, secondary leadership should come and the youth should move ahead with the guidelines with the ideas of the elders.

Later, Chandramouli thanked the newly elected group thanked them and advised to put age limits to define youth.

Later, Mr. Sai Babu, a guide to all Sistakarana members, said that we shouldn't be shy of being a Sistakaranam, everyone should come forward, the secondary leadership must be there, the elders should be respected, the yuva sena should come forward doing their work, they should enumerate how many people are in the village or districts where they live, should consult the state leadership and should unite everyone.

Later, Chandrababu said that what the elders said is absolutely true and that youth should move forward as leaders. He commended the idea of Yuva Sena.

Lumbur Srinivasa said that the Yuva Sena idea is excellent but it should not be confined to Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Later, Bhasuri Srinivasa Rao thanked the elders for their suggestions that were acceptable to all the Yuva Sena and said that the youth should go with the guidance of elders without taking their own decisions, and should help each other mentally and financially in a planned manner.

Ravi Karakavalasa said Sista Karanam Yuva Sena should have short and long term goals.

Though Sri Bhima Rao could not stay for long, he said that the youth should move forward taking along everyone, should promote the well-being of our caste, and wanted all to grow from youth to leaders.
