Meeting Notes

Inviting the audience, Narasimha Rao Mantri explained the importance of Soft skills, SWAT Analysis, Interview & Group Discussion Skills, Competitive exams inputs etc. He talked about communication skills, problem solving, team work, work ethics, time management. Narrating his experience on these aspects, he stressed as why these soft skills are important not only for interviews but also to excel in the career at workplace. In this connection, he informed the house about undertaking of these skill development programs in near future and requested all needy to participate.

Naraharinath Sekharamantri talked about efficient preparation for interviews, group discussion skills and acquisition of knowledge for competitive examinations. He also explained about process of any discussion from introduction to conclusion. All the members appreciated for his clarity on the issue.
