One aspect about this newsletter, which we are still figuring out, is the statutory need for registering it. Our initial assessment is that this newsletter may not need

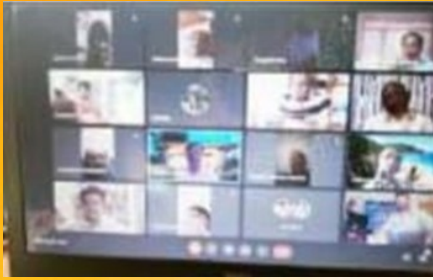

Leaders congratulate new OBC member

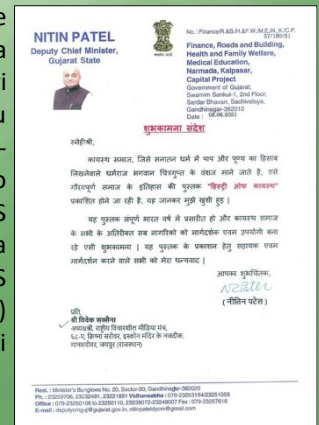

EDITORIAL

Planet Transit in July 2021

According to astrology, the movement of planets affects the life of a person. It is important to know the change of planets and their effects. In this editorial, we'll learn about the planetary motion in the month of July 2021.

As seen from the Earth, the Sun, Moon, and planets all appear to move along the ecliptic. More precisely, the

ecliptic is the Sun's apparent path among the stars over the course of a year. (Of course, it's actually the Earth that moves about the Sun, and not the other way around, but because of our orbital motion, the Sun seems to move across the backdrop of distant stars.) The planets don't remain exactly on the ecliptic, but they always stay fairly close to it.

Four planets will change their zodiac in the month of July 2021. These four planets include Mercury, Sun, Mars and Venus. In these, the planet Mercury will change its zodiac twice this month. At the beginning of the month, first Mercury will enter its own sign Gemini, then in the end this month Mercury will move to the Moon sign Cancer. The change of zodiac of these four planets is both auspicious and inauspicious on all the zodiac signs.

It can be effective. Sun God will move to Cancer this month, while Venus and Mars will enter Leo sign. The change of zodiac sign of Sun God is known as Sankranti. That is, in the month of July, Karka Sankranti will be celebrated on 16th.

In those days people were socially discriminated. I decided to serve the society as a lawyer by uplifting them judiciously. I have started practicing as an Advocate in Kharagpur Sub-Divisional Court and District Court in Midnapore.

What are your interests?

I am Interested in literature. I am a Poet, dramatist, Play Writer, Stage Artist, Stage Director. Participated in an one Act Play "PRASANTA NILAYAM" aired from All India Radio, Visakhapatnam in their Karmikula Karyakramam Programme. Participated in some Kavi Sammelanas also.

Pl share about your services to Sistakaranam Community

I have been associated with SISTAKARANA ASSOCIATION, KHARAGPUR, SINCE 50 YEARS and served the ASSOCIATION, in different Capacities. Presently Chief Advisor, SISTAKARANA ASSOCIATION, KHARAGPUR.

Organised All India Sistakarana Association programmes in Kharagpur. 4 times National level programs like Marriage Bureau, OBC meet, All India Sistakaranam Women's Conference which were attended by all National Leaders like Late. A. V. JAGANNADHA RAO, Late. S. V. RAMANA MURTY PATNAIK, Late KRISHNAMURTY PATNAIK, Sri POLUMAHANTI UMAMAHESWAR RAO, Sri V.MOHAN RAO, Sri D.V.KRISHNA RAO, Sri S.MURALI BHAGWAN etc., during my regime as GENERAL SECRETARY of the SKA/ Kharagpur.

I was one of the VICE PRESIDENTS of All India Sista Karana Association. Presently, I am WORKING PRESIDENT, ALL INDIA PRAVASANDHRA SISTAKARANA ASSOCIATION. Wishing to celebrate CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS of our SKA/ Kharagpur with poms and pageantry which fell due since 2020. It could not be organised due to Pandemic situation. Once the cloud of Pandemic is completely clear, we will organise the Centenary Celebrations in a large scale on National Level.

What makes you to serve our community

I love my community and its rich culture because I have seen its zenith and its golden era and I had an opportunity to meet with all the stalwarts of our Community including Late PRAHALAD PATNAIK GARU and saw their dedicated services and their love and affection for our community. I am very much concerned and highly disturbed to observe the diminishing flavour of our community day by day.

What are your future plans for our community?

From AIPSKA we want to draw a road map for our coming generations so that they may continue our legacy. As of now our community is in a very critical juncture. 95% of our families do not know our community language. Present generation is going out of our community bindings. Some are not using our surnames also with their names. Ofcourse it has become the order of the present day. Disowning their kith and kins, Leaving their old parents to their fate really hurts me. Single agenda can not be our mission. We

need to reach out to our people of our respective areas who are in distress. Posts, port folios will not feed us. Flexies culture, self promotions, will not be materialised. AIPSKA is started to about 20 months ago with the sole intention to do yeoman service to our community. We started with online entertainment programs due to Covid. Got huge response. Our Hon'ble Chief Patron Sri G.S.Patnaik garu has advised us to start social services, arrange marriages to our poor girls, arrange for imparting education to the poor students who are unable to afford to send their children during my tenure as Secretary.

We are going to organise Mass Thread Ceremony function in a large scale shortly to poor members of our community.

Your Vision about our Community?

I want to see a vibrant Sistakaranam Community in the colourful days to come. Our educates, talented youths, doctors, Management guys, Teachers, Engineers, researchers, our corporate youths should come to the helm of affairs of our community. They should take our beloved community to new directions, new heights and new dimensions. They need to help our student aspirants in choosing their right careers, right institutions for their studies. Our boys are found to be directionless now. They should be informed about employment opportunities and avenues wherever it is available. For this purpose, some "Consultancy groups" are suggested to be formed by our intellectuals. I want to see such talents in our community that they should not run after the jobs and stand in bee ques before the jobmela or any Consultancy service offices but jobs should come to them.

Secondly, I am very much disturbed to see the system of functioning of "Sistakarana Marriage Bureaus" which are functioning without any infrastructure and direction.

In the year 2006 when Late Krishna Murty Patnaik garu has started this in the name of "SISTAKARANA MARRIAGE BUREAU", I suggested him to change the name as "SISTAKARANA MARRIAGE INFORMATION BUREAU" to avoid legal complications. So he did.

It is observed that the parents who are showing abundant interest and eagerness in getting the names of their children registered with such information Bureaus are not feeling the responsibility to give feedbacks to Bureau officials when the marriages of their children are either fixed or negotiated or already performed or have reservations about making negotiations with distant places. It is an open secret that the Bureaus are giving free services by taking lot of pains in this restless age.. Out of ten candidates, registered with them if two marriages are settled or fixed with the candidates of their lists, the Bureau officials will be obviously feel happy that their mission is responding positively but no one gives any feedback. It is most unfortunate thing.

I told some Bureau Chiefs to take some written undertaking from the registrant parents that they would inform the Bureau Officials as soon as their marriage are settled or negotiated or performed and also their reservations about giving their wards in distant places.

I also suggested to cross check the genuinity of the candidates and their particulars and their family backgrounds with the help of our Local

A Wizard of Words

Famous Cine & Drama Writer,

Late Shri Ganesh Patro Garu. We remember him fondly on his Jayanti Smriti. . .

Birth: June 22, 1945. Parvathipuram, Vijayanagaram District. Wife: Lakshmi Kumari

Late Sri Ganesh Patro's father worked as a karanam for a small village near Parvathipuram. Ganesh's primary education took place there. Since there was no high school in the village, he bought a house in Parvathipuram and kept Ganesh with his grandmother in it. Taking advantage of the time when he did not have much intelligence, he started acting in plays, reading school books as well as literature. Soon after that the whole family moved to Parvathipuram. Inspired by the rhetoric of the time he tried to write rhythmic poetry in the local Visakha dialect but it was not successful. After completing P. U. C. , he joined Andhra University for higher studies. There he began writing plays and performing on stage as joint secretary for the University Cultural Association.

Drama, theatrical life:

Since childhood he was crazy about movies. After watching the movie, some of the scenes in the movie were done by his fellow children. In Parvathipuram, Shri Domanu Suryanarayana Shri Oleti Buchibabu were his teachers. Married to daughter of Stage director in Andhra University.

In 1970 started writing and within five years got accolades. There was some time when character dialogue means only Ganesh patro name was known. The Uttarandhra dialect is very nice in his conversations Proverbs around Parvathipuram introduced in his movies

He gained fame in India with the play Kodu Puttala. The play was translated into all Indian languages and aired on All India Radio and Television. Ganesh Patro, who started writing in the 1970s, became a first-rate playwright in five years. Although there are very few works, every play and play written is acclaimed by the aestheticians who tie the knot on the stage. Ganesh Patro is a talented person who exuded a new scent in comprehending the story object, narration, characterization, scene combination and word composition. His writing style specializes in powerfully discovering the problem through events.

Mrityunjaya, Terachiraju, Tarangalu, Asura-sandhya Natakalu, Kodu Puttala, Pavala, Labham, Triveni, Agandi! Plays like Think A Little etc. are the best works that stole the admiration of the Andhra audience.

He provided dialogues and narration for several films from the 1970s to the 1990s. Fifteen years later, he returned to filmy world and composed dialogues for the film Seethamma vakitalo Sirimalle Chettu. "Hello Guru Premakosamera ee jeevitham" the song in the Nirnayam movie was written by him.

His cinema dialogues include Seethamma vakitlo Sirimalle Chettu, Nirnayam, Seetharamyya gari manumaraalu, Rudraveena, Talambara, Preminchu Pelladu, Mayuri, Manishiko Charithra, Guppedu Manasu, Idi katha kadu, Mapalle lo Gopaludu.

Courage, peace of mind, praying to God for them these three are the best and great doctors.

We need to keep our minds calm. Calmness can be achieved through prayer to God. When calm comes, then self-confidence increases. Conquering of anything comes with self confidence.

As calmness and courage come from praying to God, let us pray God during the following festivals in the month of July / Ashadha. Thus let us achieve good health and prosperity.

Hatha yoga

After reading that Brahman is absolute truth, one may want to know steps to see the truth within, and realize the self. One might wonder if there are any methods to be able to see the self and become liberated. Yoga is known to be the best road to self realization.

While any of the ways of Bhakti, Jnana, Karma will lead to liberation, Yoga is known to offer shortest way to liberation, and hence superior in that sense. It is also known as Raja Yoga, or Hatha Yoga. In order to achieve liberation through Yoga, one needs to have a sadGuru guiding in the path.

Yoga is not simply exercises for good health, as the modern day people may think. It is the way to attain ultimate goal of ones human life, it is a tool to achieve Moksha. Yogi, and Rishi Patanjali has laid out 8 limbs of Yoga in Yoga sutras. Yoga that has been discussed in Upanishads like Yoga chudamani, Jabala darsana, and Yoga Sikha has been brought to popular notice by Patanjali. There are many ways and variations to Yoga that Gurus teach in Guru parampara.

It is important to have a Guru that Shishya surrenders to in order to progress to self realization. Even if one do not find a Guru in the beginning, if one practises Yoga from acquired understanding through books, and videos it is known that Guru appears in Sishyas life when the student is ready for serious practise. The 8 limbs of Hatha Yoga are Yama, Niyama, Asana, Pranayama, Prathyahara, Dharana, Dhyana and Samadhi. Yoga requires one to follow Yama, and Niyama.

Yamas are ethical rules namely Ahimsa, Satya, Asteya (Not stealing), Brahmacharya, Aparigraha (non greediness for material riches). Niyamas include, Purity, Contentment Tapas, Study of scriptures, Ishvarapranidhana (Contemplation of Brahman). Asana limb doesn't require one to

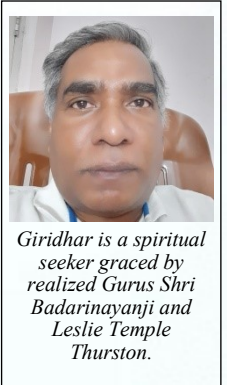
be able to perform all kind of Yoga asanas.

While they are good, the basic requirement is to be able to sit in padmasana or Sukhasana for hours together without moving at all. Asanas prepare the body for this. Pranayama is the control of Prana (breath) and many techniques have been there as to how to control breath.

Breath control includes Pooraka, Rechaka and Kumbhaka phases that are prescribed to be done in certain ways in Upanishads. Since Brahman is with in, and the ability to with draw from the outward senses is practised in Yoga, usually by closing eyes and in sitting in a silent place. This withdrawal from senses is pratyahara.

Dharana is to achieving single pointed concentration, without wavering mind. Mind is tricky and it wanders for a normal person. Through Dharana one achieves a single pointed mind. Object may be such as realizing Brahman, and knowing omniscience. Dhyana is to silence all the thoughts of mind and exploring deeper states of inner silence. Samadhi is the last stage of an advanced Yogi, where it is was described by those achieved this stage as some thing unexplainable.

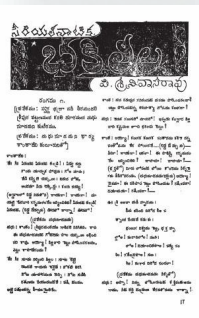
At this stage mind is completely dropped, and the Yogi maintains only the witness of Brahman. While this description of Yoga is not enough to practise Yoga, it gives an overview of it for interested. More will be covered on it in further issues.

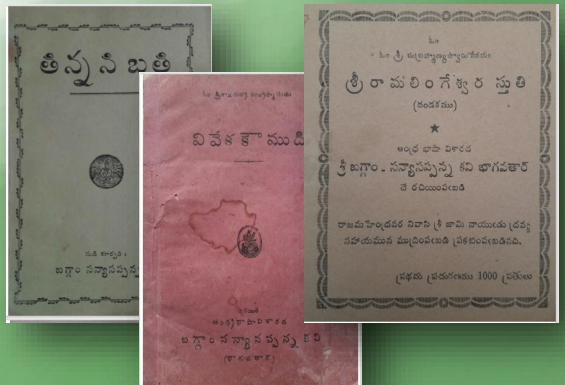

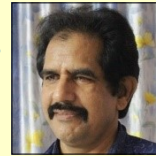
